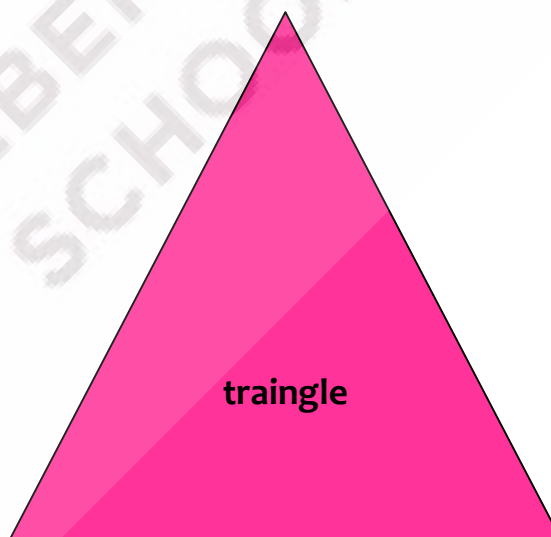
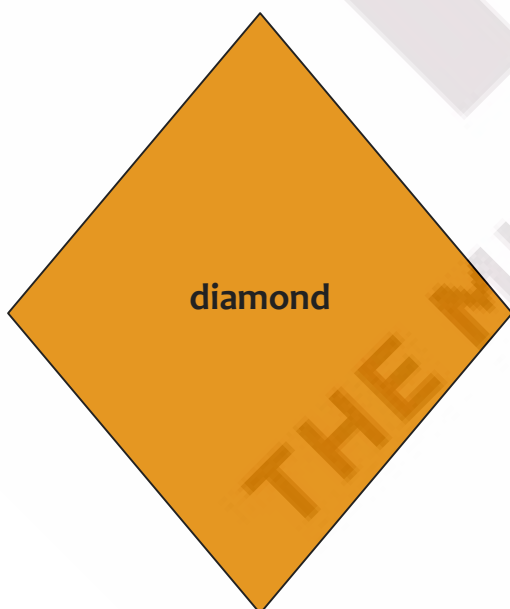
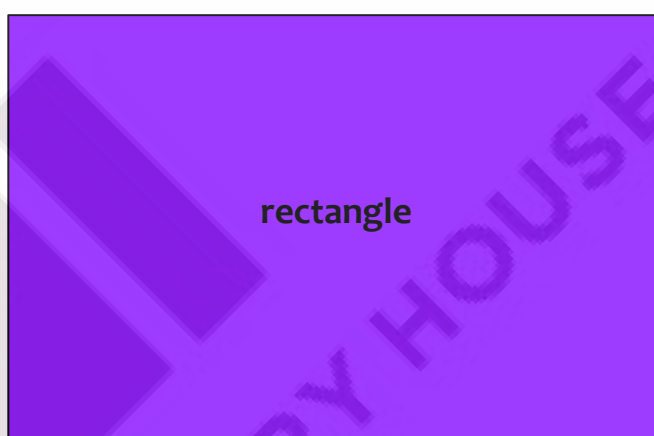
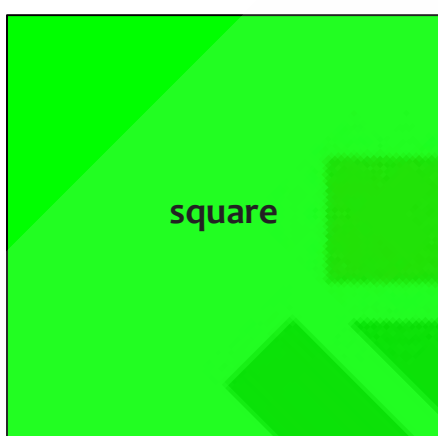
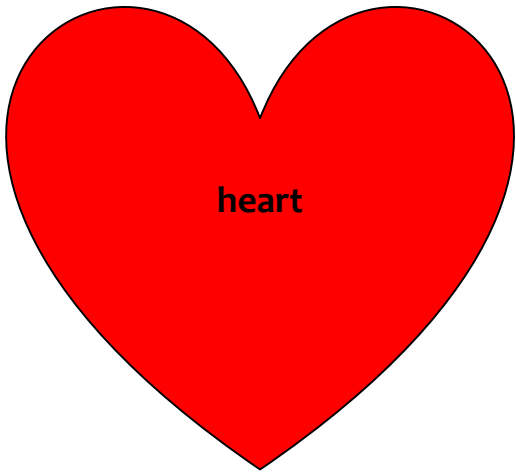


Find the shape

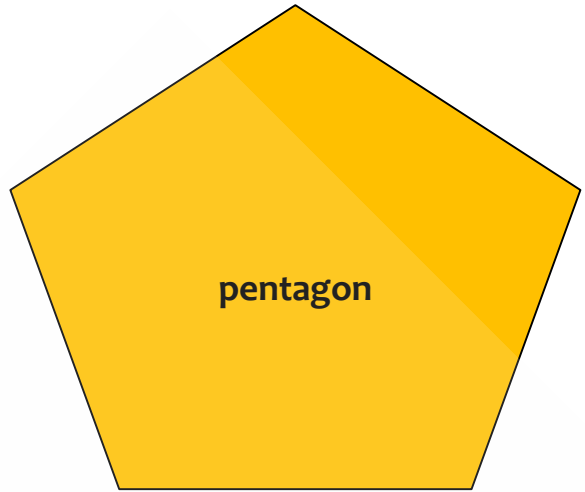
Instructions:

Lay the different shapes out in front of you and your child. Discuss the different shapes together, naming them and talking about the properties; counting the corners, sides etc. Then you can hide the shapes in different places, either inside or in the garden. You and your child can then go on a shape hunt. Each time they find a shape encourage them to name the shape and to talk about it. You can also look for the shape in your environment, e.g. rectangle – door, book; circle – clock, plate, etc.

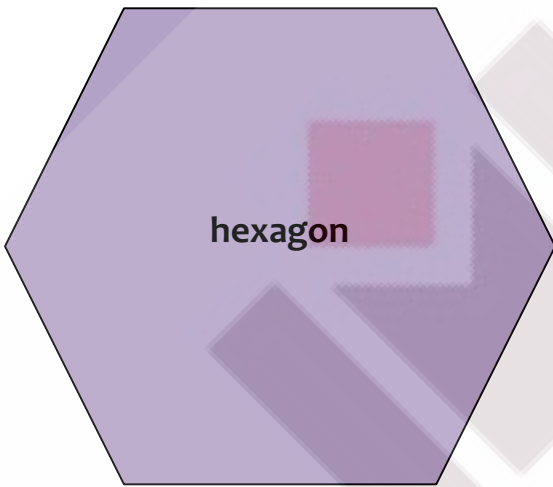
