## **Hidden Chicks!**



This is how you can make a chick that hides within an egg! There is a split pin that allows the egg to open and close so the children can have a lot of fun with this!

## You will need:

- Coloured card (this is important, paper wont be strong enough) CHOOL
  - **Scissors**
  - Collage materials
  - Glue
  - **Feathers**
  - Split pin
  - 1) Cut out the egg! First the outline of the egg and then they need to cut a zigzag line across the middle.
  - 2) Decorate the egg with collage materials and glue

- 3) Attach the split pin to the corner of the zig-zag in the middle of the egg
- 4) Make a chick out of yellow card, cut around the shape and stick it so it looks like it is popping out of one of the halves of the egg
- 5) Model to the children how they can hide and reveal the chick!

Some templates are included down below, but if the children are in badgers class or above, see if they can draw their own chick shape.

Equally, the children may choose to draw their own egg shape.
