

Michelle's Fun Easter Maths Challenge_____

Get parents to roll pages of newspaper into eggs and scramble them around the room/garden.

Place around 2/3 eggs in each area, when finding the eggs encourage the children to record their findings onto paper or a whiteboard. Once this is done add the total amount of eggs together.

This activity is a fun way to participate in an Easter egg hunt challenge. The challenge encourages the children to hunt and search indoors or outdoors for eggs, working out how many they have found altogether.

The activity encourages the children to add more and combine groups to find the total. Great for reinforcing concepts and practising children's addition skills. Recording the amount as they go along.

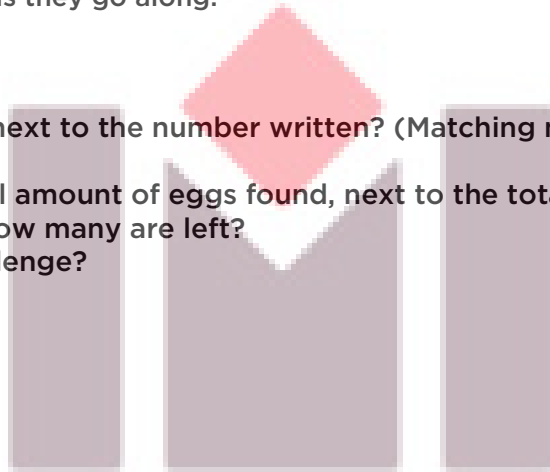
Questions to ask:_____
