Activity: listen to Tim reading Susan Eame’s story *Cold Feet*. Tim will tell you when you need to pause the story and answer the questions on the worksheet.



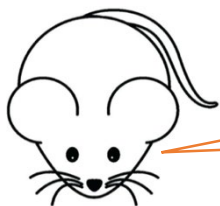
Questioning Koala (who always asks questions), asks this question today:
