I'm Responding Raccoon and I'd like to know what you think. Write your answer here.



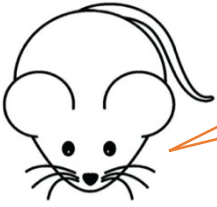
I think Baloo's song is about...



Questioning Koala next asks: **Do you think there is a difference between what you *need* and what you *want*?**

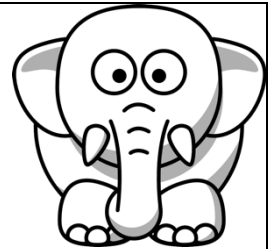
Let's get a quick response first. Circle one answer:





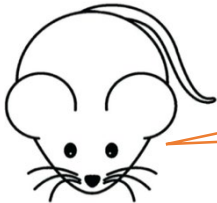
I'm a reasoning rodent and I'd love to know the reason for why you answered Yes or No. Can you explain here?
