<p>This week we are continuing with our learning on time.</p> <p>Let's recap telling the time together here.</p> <p>Now look at this reading the time worksheet.</p> <p>Once you are feeling confident in that I would like you to have a look at these worded problems based on calculating durations.</p>	<p>A rhyme is when two words end with the same sound. e.g. Moon and Spoon both have the same sound at the end of the word. OO.</p> <p>An easy way to find words that rhyme is in your head. First pick a word. EG. CAT...what ending sound does CAT have? AT... Find another word that ends with the same sound. AT. FAT, HAT, BAT. It rhymes because the end of the word has the same sound. When we write a poem we only need to make the last word of each line rhyme.eg. My family has a cat. He's really fat.</p> <p>You don't have to make every line rhyme. You can do every other. eg. Hercules avoided baths all week LONG, Though it left him dirty No one ever felt so STRONG</p> <p>Long and strong rhyme. They have the same sound at the end. NG.</p> <p>Your turn! 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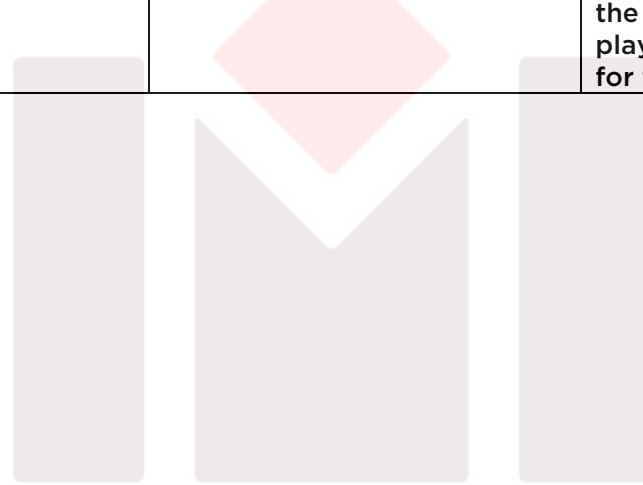
