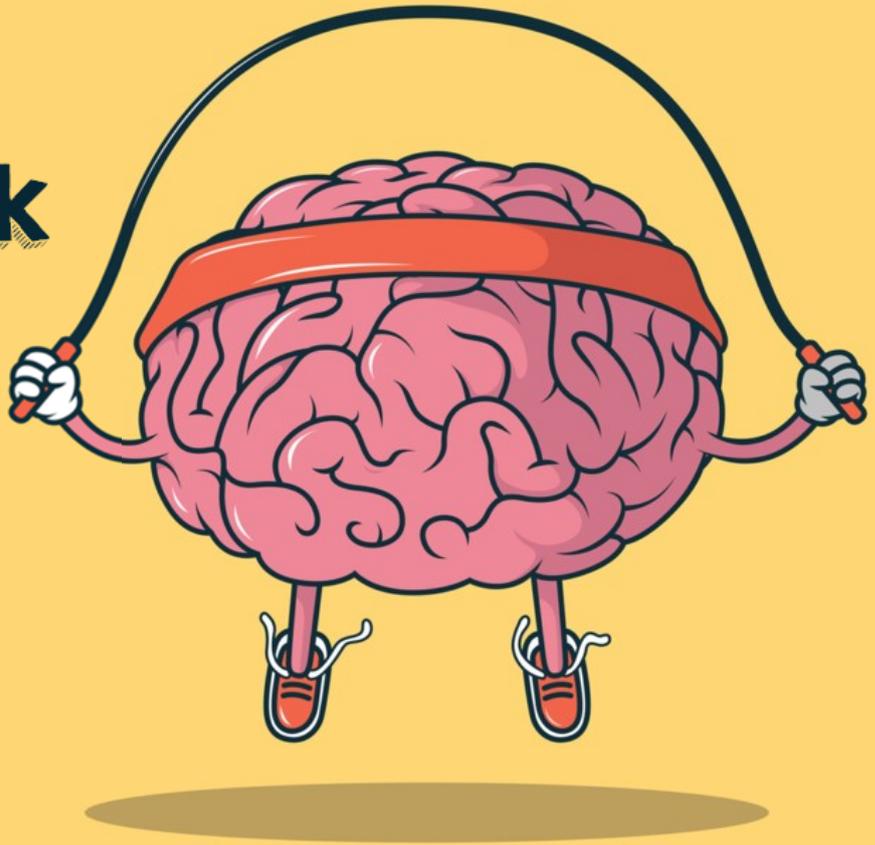

Subject: Maths

This week in Maths the Hedgehog's class will be looking at the concept of long and short. The children will be taking part in an activity to create their own train track connecting carriages together and discussing its length. The children will be encouraged to order the trains according to their size and length. Focusing on numbers this week we will be recapping numbers 1-5. The children will be given numbered cars that they will need to order and attempt to match to the correct parking space to successfully park the car.

Subject: Literacy

Our story of the week is 'The Night Iceberg'. This week we will be encouraging the Hedgehogs' class to follow the story by asking questions allowing them to anticipate what may happen next. This is a great way to extend children's focus by giving them the chance to participate throughout the story. We will be using the water from ice cubes in our mark making lessons to create our marks on the chalk boards using a variety of brushes and sponges. We will talk about the process of the ice and how and why its melting. This is an easy activity you can recreate at home. By placing the ice in different areas/ temperatures and it opens up a discussion and encourages the children to ask questions.

Subject: Project

This week we move on from our Pet project to Transport! The Hedgehogs' class will be looking at trains and how they have changed over time, making comparisons from what they look like to how they sound and move. As part of our project we will be talking this week about how we all get to school. A discussion with the children on the way to school will be a great prompt for this activity.
