

## Subject: Literacy

In our Phonics lesson this week we will be looking at two new sounds; c and k. By the end of the week, we would like the children to be able to correctly form and identify words that begin with the curly c letter and words that begin with kicking k letter.

In our news lesson this week we will be focusing on the book "Handa's surprise". The children are familiar with the book as it is a class favourite. The children will be talking about the who, what and where in the story and focusing on the different fruits in the basket and the animals Handa meets on her journey to Akeyo.

To continue their learning at home, ask your child to recreate the story using different fruits they can find around the house. Talk to your child about their favourite part of the story and explain why this is.

## Subject: Maths

This week in our Maths lesson we will be focusing on identifying the missing numbers from numbers 1-15. Encourage your children to practice this at home by scattering number flash cards on the floor and asking them to order them and to identify if any numbers are missing.

In Maths project the children will be creating symmetrical butterfly wing patterns using shapes and colours. At home you can create your own symmetrical picture by halving the paper and asking your child to draw symmetrical shapes on both sides to create their own symmetrical picture.

## Subject: Project

This week in the Transition class we will be celebrating Black History Month. We will be focusing on Rosa Parks and why she had a pivotal role in changing our society. The children will be using this as a guide to understand why we are respectful and kind towards everyone. This week we would like you to continue this at home by asking your child to demonstrate an act of kindness for someone else.
