1:15-3:00pm	<p>Co-Curricular Activities</p> <p>Option A: <u>Design your own bookmark!</u> You wouldn't want to lose track of where you were up to in the story that you are reading.</p> <p>So here is a chance to design your own bookmark!</p> <p>What you need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Coloured paper - Thread or pipe cleaner - Sticker - optional - Glitter - optional - Scissors - Hole puncher <p>What you need to do:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pick a choice of coloured paper 2. Using the scissors safely with an adult cut out a long rectangle shape. Make sure that it is not longer than your book. 3. Use a hole puncher to punch a hole at the top of the book mark (make sure that you are with an adult) 4. Tie a thread or pipe cleaner (ask an adult for help) 5. Use plain paper to make a long line on a floor or wall. 2. Use the tape to stick the number line on, make sure that you get help doing this. 3. Using a black marker pen draw a line in the middle of the page going from one end to another. 4. Then make smaller lines under the number line. Make sure that you space out these smaller lines. Make 51 of these so that the number cards 0-50 can fit under. 5. Using the blu tack to stick the number cards correctly in order from 0-51. <p>Now, see if you can complete your own addition and subtraction sums using your own number line.</p> <p>Remember that we move forwards when adding and backwards when subtracting.
