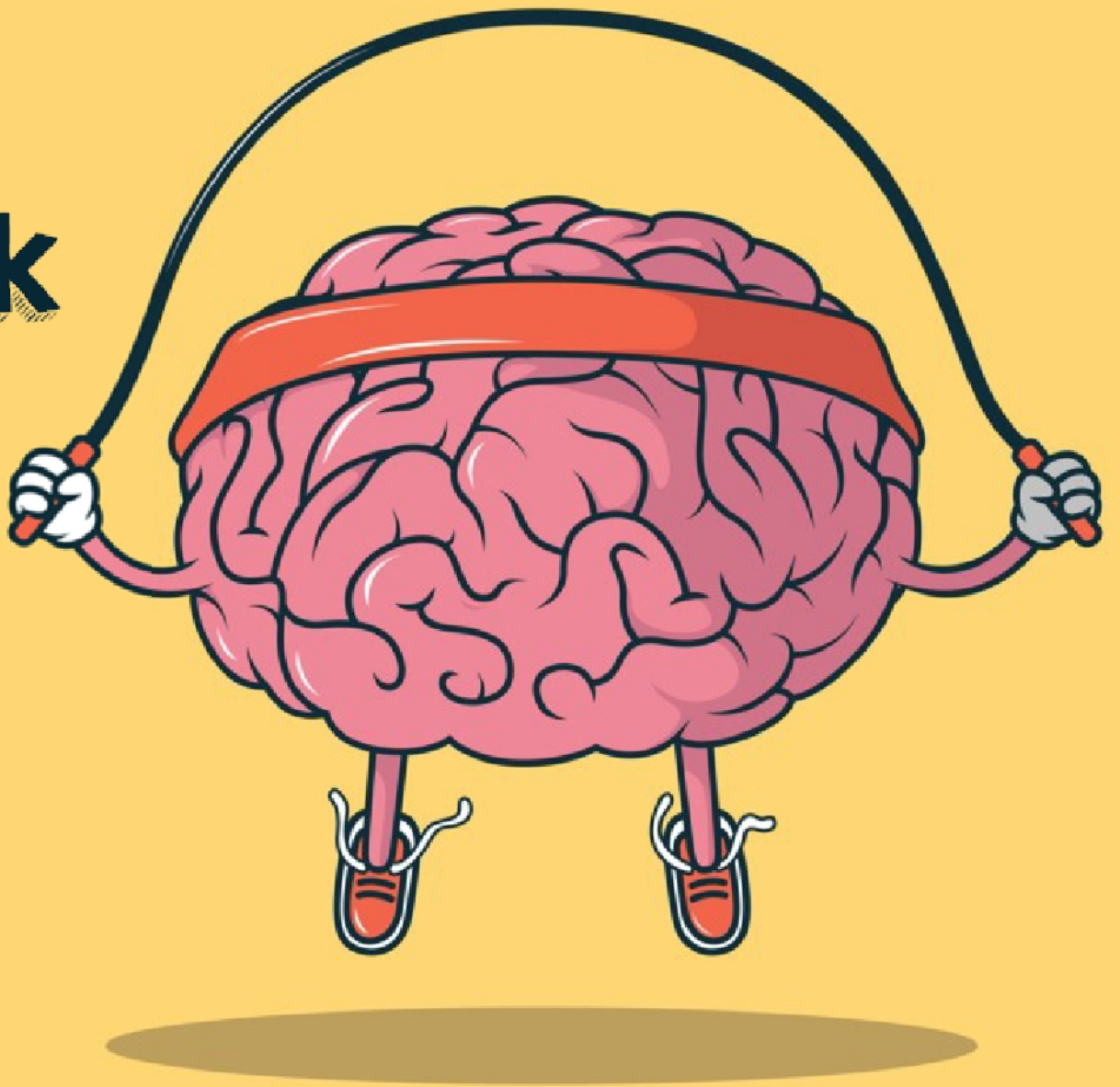

# This week we are learning to...



## Literacy

This week in Creative Writing, the pupils will continue to read the class book James and the Giant Peach. The children will be blindfolded and will think of as many adjectives as they can to describe the smell of a peach. Children will then have the opportunity to taste the fruit. They will then focus on using their senses to write their own description of the peach using adjectives and similes. At home, the children can continue to practice creating their own similes, using like or as to describe objects around them.

## Maths

This week in Maths, the pupils will recap counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. They will take part in a range of activities using concrete materials. The pupils will also learn how to use a 100 square to aid their work. We will use the concepts 'count', 'multiple', 'pattern' and 'sequence' to describe the relationship between different numbers and will observe the different patterns that occur. At home, the children can use two dice (making two digits) and can roll and count in 2s, 5s and 10s from that number.

## Project

This week in Project, the children will be learning about what recycling is and why it is important. The pupils will learn about the 4Rs, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle and Rethink. They will discuss what each R means and what we can do to preserve the environment. At home, the pupils can create a poster promoting recycling and discuss the 4Rs.

## Science

This week in Science, the children will learn about the sun and look into how shadows are created. They will observe how the position of the sun changes at different times in the day, which does not necessarily mean that the sun is moving. The children will understand the sun's importance and create sundials, and will make and record observations over the next week. At home, the pupils can also create their own sundial and observe the changes that occur with the position of the sun in their area.
