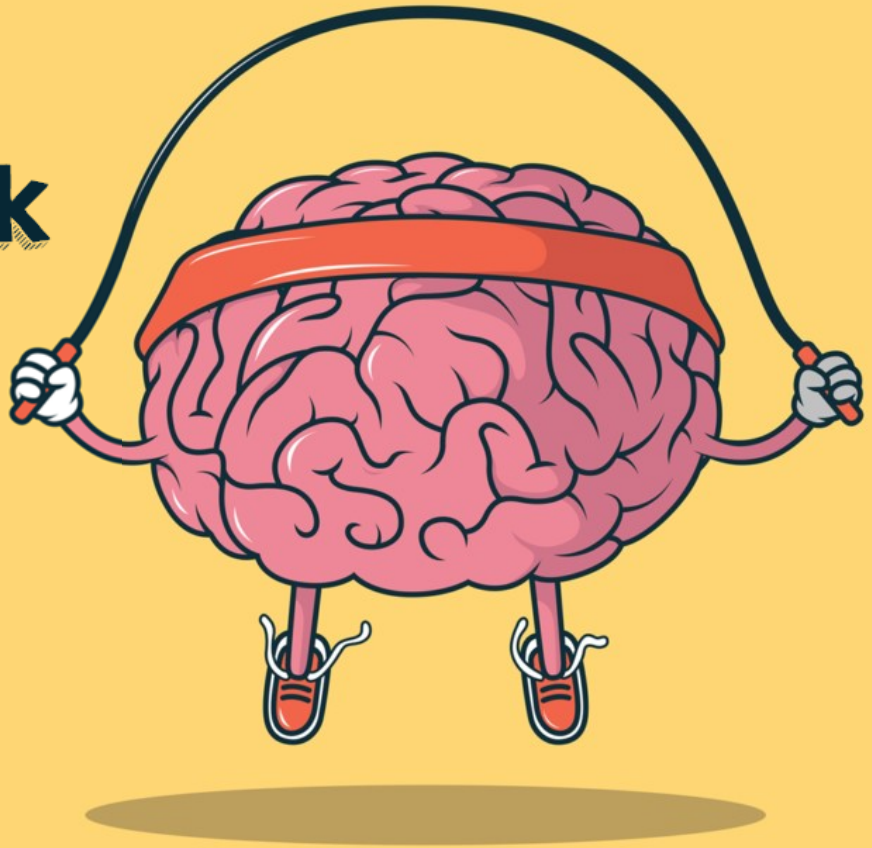

This week we are learning to...



Literacy

This week the children will focus on the use of direct speech in their writing. They will learn how to use speech marks to show dialogue and will use their knowledge of synonyms to find words other than said to use in their direct speech writing. At home you could create your own family comic strip showcasing direct speech using speech marks,

Maths

This week the children will continue to solve subtraction problems using a variety of strategies, for example, using a number line, partitioning and even the column method! The children will explore and learn to approach subtraction problems using different strategies to help them. They will be exploring the different vocabulary around subtraction and apply their written strategies to answer one-step worded problems. At home, you can create vocabulary maps together to encourage your child to think about the different subtraction vocabulary.

Project

The children will be developing their historic skills through looking at the impact the digital revolution has had on the environment and our lives. They will be using sources to help them identify these causes as well as having a greater understanding of how the digital revolution has changed overtime. At home, the children could create a digital leaflet on the Purple Mash platform to share their knowledge of the digital revolution.

Science

The children will continue their learning of the Earth in space by looking at the importance of the Sun. They will develop their understanding of the importance of the Sun for life on Earth and look at how in the past, the Sun was used to tell the time. At home, the children can continue with their learning of the Sun by creating a fact file on why the Sun is important for our solar system.
