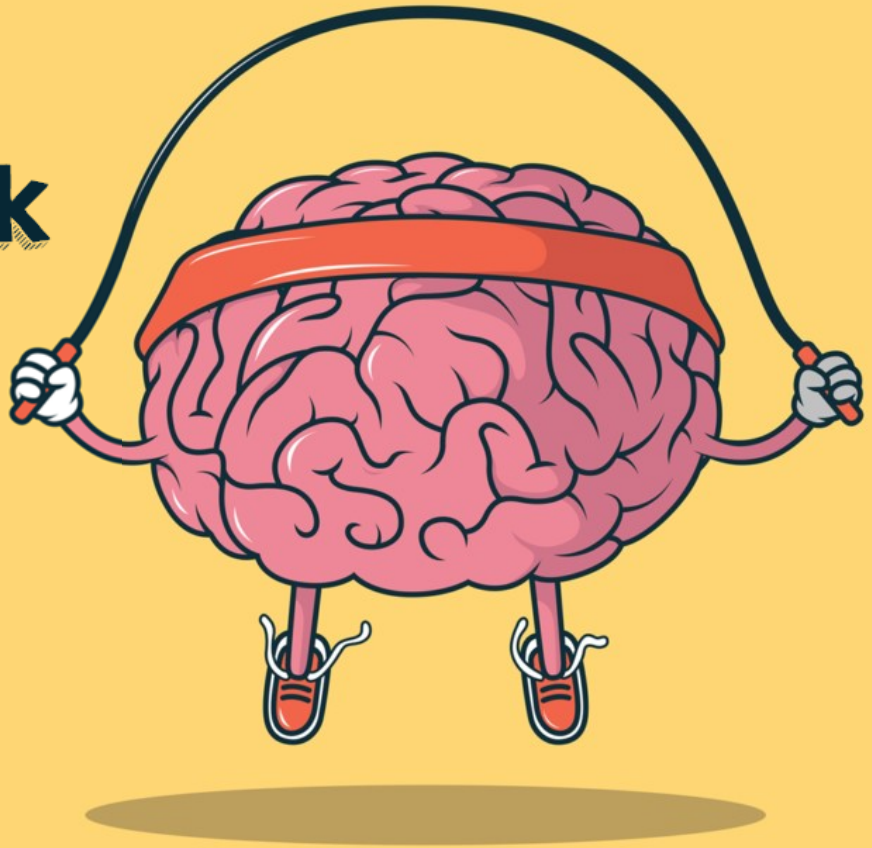

Literacy

This week the children will continue to focus on the use of direct speech in their writing. They will perfect the use of speech marks to show dialogue and will use their knowledge of synonyms to enhance their writing. At home, create your own word wall to encourage the use of WOW words in spoken and written form.

Maths

Make a given amount in different combinations of coins. The children will be setting up their own 'shop' and exploring the value of each coin. They will be challenged to find as many different ways to make a total as possible. At home, you can encourage your child to use coins to make different totals of items that they want to buy either in the supermarket or online.

Project

In project this week the children will look at air pollution. They will discover factors that contribute to the declining air quality in our local environment and London as a whole. The class will be introduced to London's Lord Mayor Sadiq Khan's policy on clean air and will discuss ways how they, as individuals, can contribute. At home you could conduct a survey and monitor how you as a family contribute to air pollution.

Science

In Science, we will begin to understand why we need the Sun. The children will form predictions, carry out independent Scientific research and draw conclusions. At home, you can set up a Sun dial in your garden and allow your child to observe this at different times of the day to support their understanding of how shadows are formed and how these change throughout the day.
