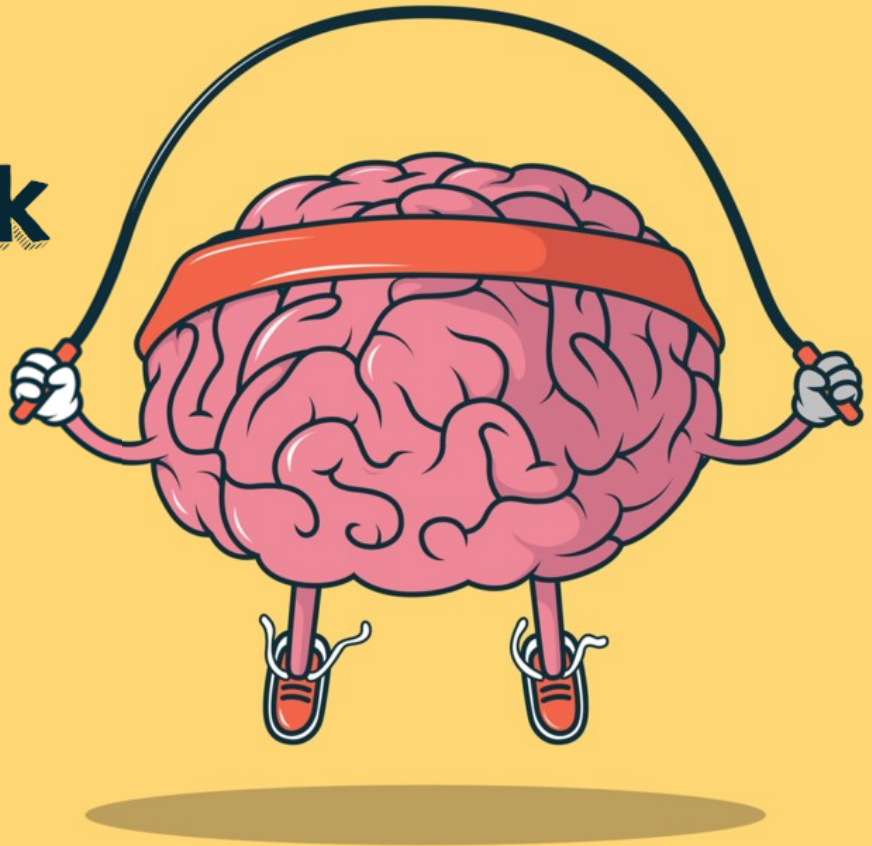

# This week we are learning to...



## Literacy

This week in Creative Writing, the children will continue to read the class book, 'The Hedgehog' by Dick-King Smith. They will recap an acrostic poem's features and use their knowledge of alliteration and rhyming to create their own 'Hedgehog' acrostic poem. At home, pupils can create their own acrostic poem using the word 'June'. Please remember to be creative and use rhyming and alliteration.

## Maths

This week in Maths the children will be revising their 5 times tables. They will use the multiplication symbol to devise number sentences and use their times table knowledge to count objects in 5 to work out different quantities. At home the children can practise counting forwards and backwards in 5's and create number sentences to test their families 5 times table knowledge. You could even host your own quiz!

## Project

This week in Project, the children will enjoy a visit from the London Field Studies Council and will have the opportunity to learn more about taking care of the environment. They will take part in an investigation at Westbere Copse, assessing the environment and how best to preserve our local wildlife. At home, pupils can create a list of different things that they can do to help maintain the environment.

## Science

This week in Science, the children will learn all about the Earth's atmosphere, looking closely at the gases it is made up of. The pupils will understand that the Earth's atmosphere is what allows us to survive on Earth. They will also explore the five layers of the Earth and understand what components are found. At home, pupils can create a poster and label the five layers of the Earth whilst remembering to use the key concepts; troposphere, stratosphere, mesosphere and thermosphere.
