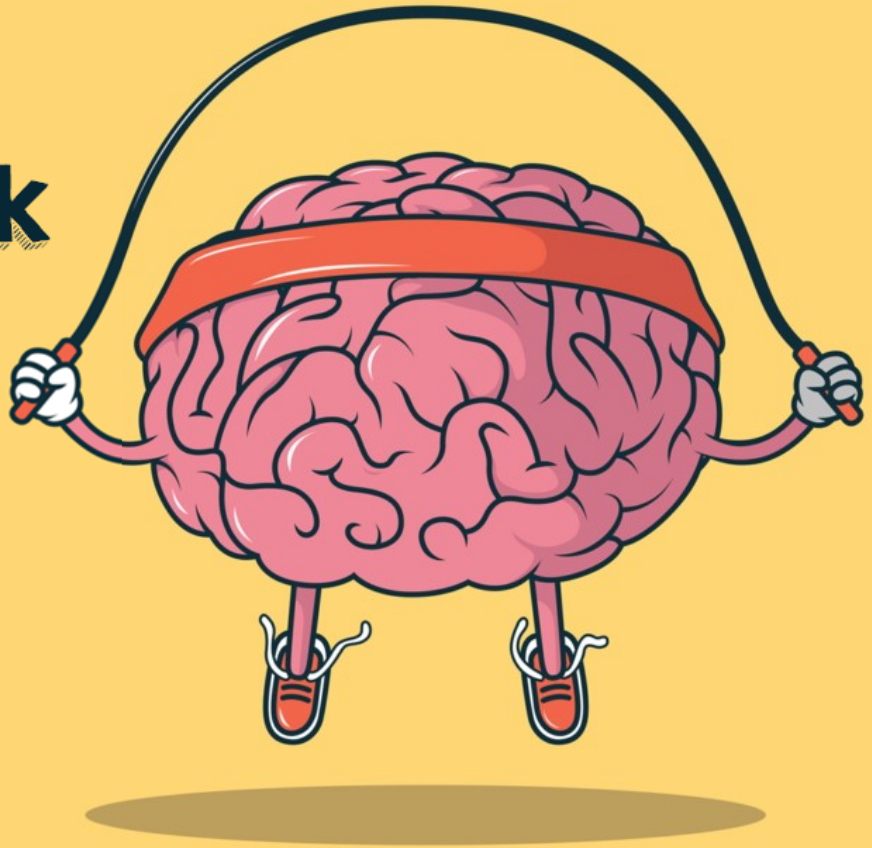

# This week we are learning to...



## Literacy

This week in Creative Writing, the children will continue to read the class book, 'The Hodgeheg' by Dick-King Smith. They will read an extract about Max's accident. The children will discuss how to be safe on the road and recap the steps of the Green Cross Code. Using time connectives and imperative verbs, pupils will create their own step by step safety poster for Max. At home, pupils can create their own version of the Green Cross Code.

## Maths

This week in Maths, the pupils will learn how to create their own pictogram. They will complete their own survey and collect the data. Using the chrome books the pupils will begin to construct their own pictogram, and will be taught to represent numbers in pictograms. The pupils will then use their knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s, 10s,  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{4}$  to represent data. At home, see if your children can create their pictogram and represent their data in 2s, 5s or 10s.

## Project

Following the London Field Studies Council visit, the children will complete a planting project at Westbere Copse. They will learn about different types of trees and how they improve our air quality. The pupils will have the opportunity to go to Westbere and explore and identify the variety of plants they think would enhance the environment. At home, see if they can observe their environment and research the different trees found and how they are beneficial in the environment.

## Science

This week in Science, the children will learn about the seasonal changes on the Earth, such as having longer daylight hours in the summer and less in the winter. They will learn about how the Earth spins on its axis to show daytime and night time. Using their knowledge on data handling, pupils will draw simple graphs and identify patterns they notice in the summer and winter months. At home, see if you can explore this further and look at how the moon is lit up by light from the sun. The BBC Bitesize have a great video on this to explore!
