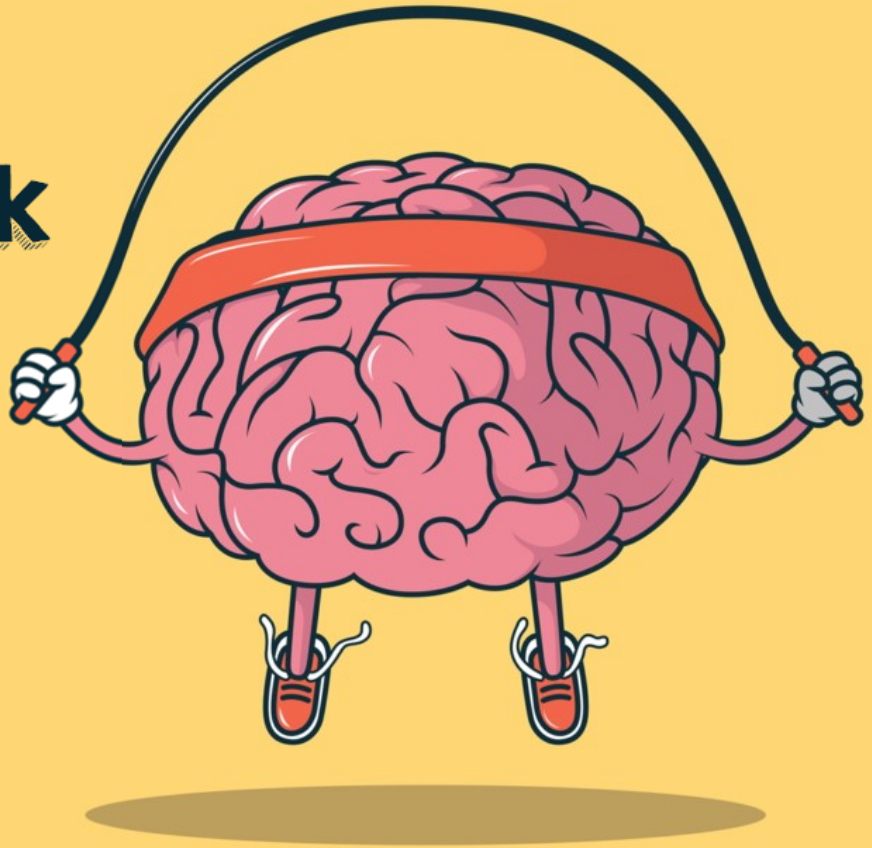

# This week we are learning to...



## Subject: Literacy

This week in Creative Writing, the children will continue to read the class book, *The Hodgeheg* by Dick-King Smith. They will be introduced to spoonerisms. A spoonerism is when the initial letter or letters are swapped around to sound humorous. Pupils will read chapter 3 of the book and will speak about what they noticed changed about Max after his accident. They will then create their own spoonerisms. At home, pupils can create their own spoonerisms and have members of their families guess what they are trying to say.

## Subject: Maths

This week in Maths, the pupils will be introduced to division. They will learn new concepts such as divide and split and will understand that objects can be divided by grouping them into equal groups. Pupils will be working in groups to complete simple division sums using concrete objects. At home, pupils can create their own simple division sums and begin to solve them using toys or objects.

## Subject: Project

This week in Project, the children will begin to learn about sustainable energy. Pupils will explore the different forms of sustainable energy and will develop their understanding of wind turbines. They will discuss what a wind turbine does and how it generates energy. Pupils will then create their own wind turbine and test this, explaining how it works and why it is beneficial to the environment. At home, pupils can research different areas where wind turbines are found.

## Subject: Science

This week in Science, the children will be continuing to learn about light and dark. However, they will be focusing on where light comes from, looking closely at light sources. They will be introduced to the concepts reflective and transparent and will have the opportunity to examine materials to sort them into reflective and transparent. At home, pupils can make a list of light sources and sort them into man made and natural light sources.
