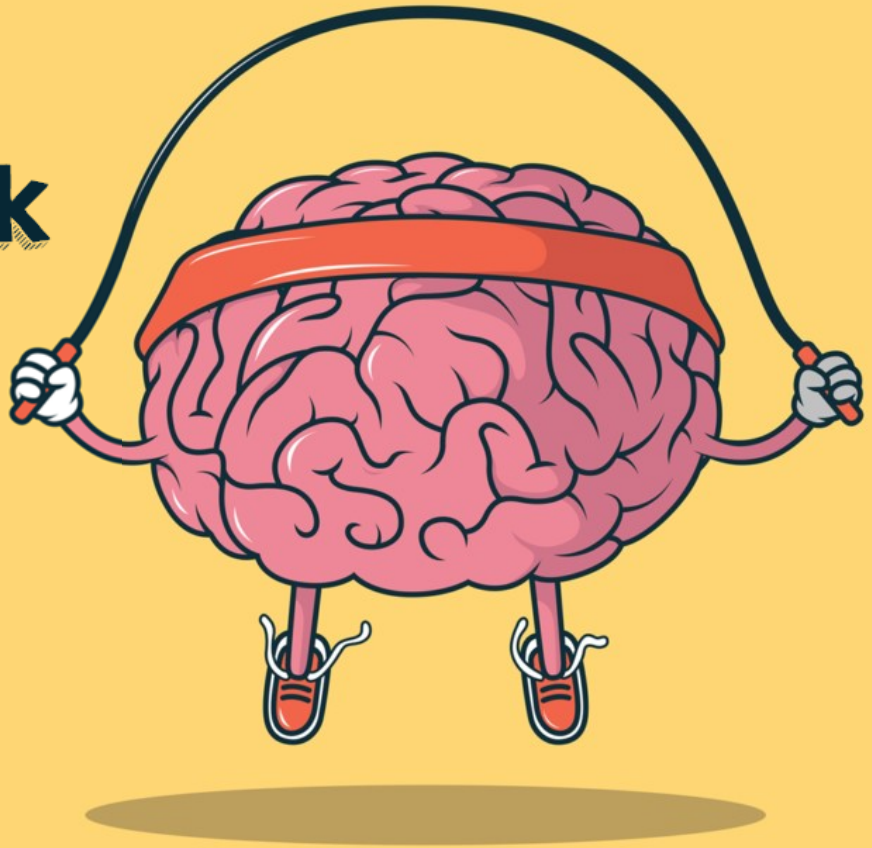

Literacy- Comprehension

This week the children will be working towards mastery of their comprehension skills. They will be learning to extract key information from a given text and interpret it to answer key questions. At home you can do this verbally during your bedtime stories.

Literacy- Creative Writing

Over the past few weeks the children have been looking at story structure. This week they will be learning to write a detailed ending for a story that already has a beginning and a middle. They will need to read the story and using their prior knowledge of story structure to help find a solution and an ending. At home you can create alternative endings to famous traditional tales.

Maths

This week the children will continue to use addition and subtraction strategies to solve two step worded problems. A two-step problem is a word problem that requires two operations to solve it. For Example:

I buy a magazine costing 83p and a pencil costing 45p. I pay with a voucher that gives me 20p off the things I am buying. How much do I spend?

In this case, the first operation would be addition ($83p + 45p = £1.28$).

The second operation is subtraction ($£1.28 - 20p = £1.08$). Practise posing simple problems to your children at home when you do your grocery shopping.

Science

The children will continue to develop their understanding of the phases of the Moon. The children will look at how the sunlight affects the way the Moon looks throughout the day and be able to describe which phase is which by naming them.
