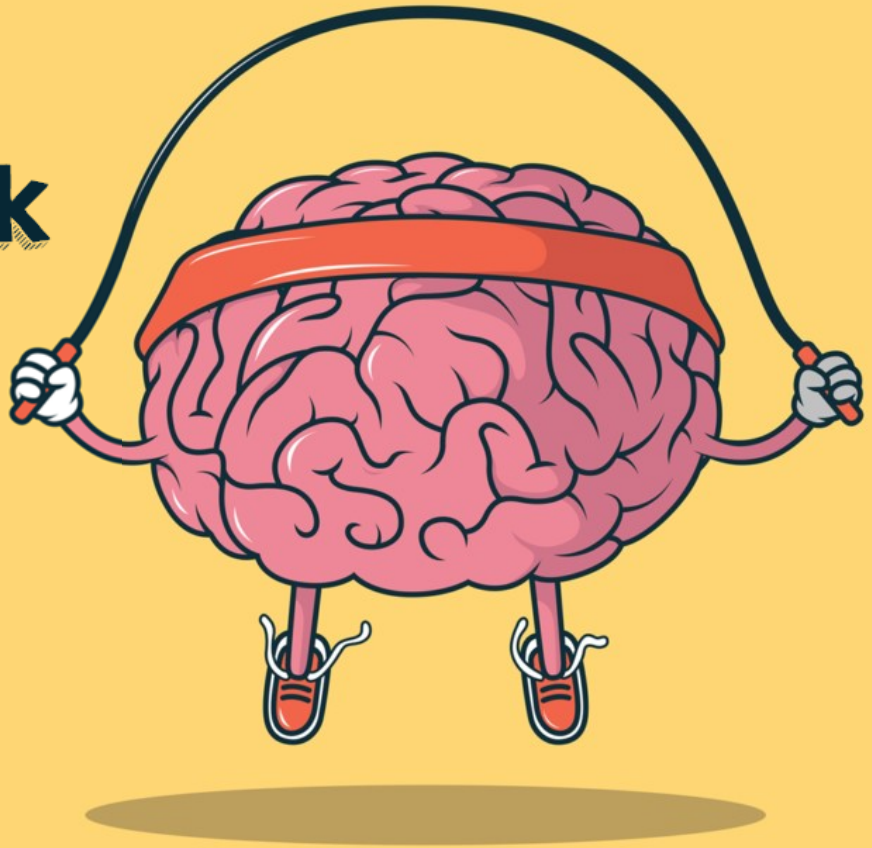

This week we are learning to...



Subject: Literacy - Creative Writing

During our Creative Writing lesson this week, the children will be writing a book review for our current chapter book, 'The Boy in the Dress'. The children will be encouraged to rate the book and identify their favourite part of the book as well as their favourite character. Using their reflective and critical thinking skills the children will be encouraged to provide reasons for each of their opinions. The children will be encouraged to apply a range of punctuation and vocabulary to ensure that their written work catches the attention of the reader. At home, you can encourage your child to discuss this book to engage their enthusiasm for the lesson.

Subject: Maths

This week the children will be looking at written strategies for division. They will be learning to understand that grouping and sharing are used to work out division sums. During this lesson, the children will gain an understanding that division is splitting a whole group into smaller, equal groups each time. They will apply the correct vocabulary associated with division confidently and use this alongside grouping and sharing to solve problems. At home you can support this by practising times tables with your child. Ask the children to use this knowledge to support them to answer mental questions around division, essentially they should reverse the sum.

Subject: Project

In our Project lesson this week, the children will be developing their understanding of the impact of disasters such as oil spills on the environment. They will investigate the scope of damage caused by oil spills in recent history. They will investigate the impact that these spills have on local wildlife and habitats. At home, you can support this by carrying out a fun oil spill clean up experiment. This will support their understanding of ocean pollution and allow them to further evaluate the damage that is caused.

Subject: Science

This week the children will be reflecting on their learning of 'The Earth in Space' as we have our final Science lesson of the topic. The children will be able to create posters to explain everything that they now know on the topic and will be encouraged to present these to their peers. They will have to apply the correct Scientific vocabulary and skills that they have learnt during the term. At the end of the lesson the children will be given the posters that they created at the very start of the topic and will be supported to evaluate their own learning in Science this term.
