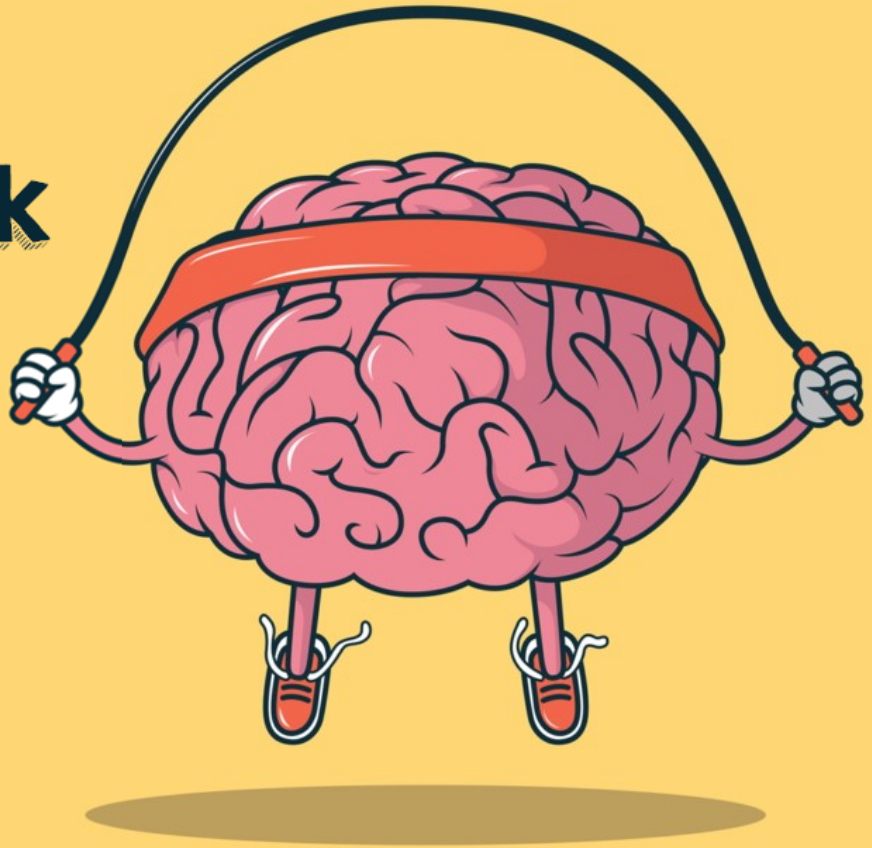

This week we are learning to...



Literacy

This week in Creative Writing, the children will continue to read the class book, *The Hodgeheg* by Dick-King Smith. The pupils will plan and write an alternative ending to the story. They will think about what could have happened to the Hedgehog and will brainstorm their suggestions. The pupils will focus on using sentence openers, speech marks, exclamation, and imagination to create their own ending. At home, the pupils can choose their favourite story and can create their own ending, remembering to use their imagination, exclamation marks and varied sentence openers.

Maths

This week in Maths, the pupils will learn about fractions as part of a whole and understand that halving is when an object is split in half. They will also be able to write the fraction $\frac{1}{2}$ to represent objects and identify $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of objects. At home the pupils could use fruits and vegetables and can cut them up into different fractions and recognise each part.

Project

This week in Project, the children will continue to learn about sustainable energy. The pupils will revise the different sustainable energy forms and look closely into sustainable transport (Electric cars). They will explore what cars run on, how this contributes to air pollution, and examine why air pollution is harmful to us and the environment. The pupils will also consider the difference between this and electric cars, how they are charged and how they are different from petrol cars. At home, your child can research the different types of sustainable transport and create a fact file to share at school.

Science

This week in Science, the children will create their own quiz and answer their own questions about the topic of 'Our Earth in Space'. This will consolidate their knowledge on this topic and will reflect on their learning throughout the term.

At home, you could get your child to complete an entry about their favourite Science lesson this term and what they would like to learn about next.
