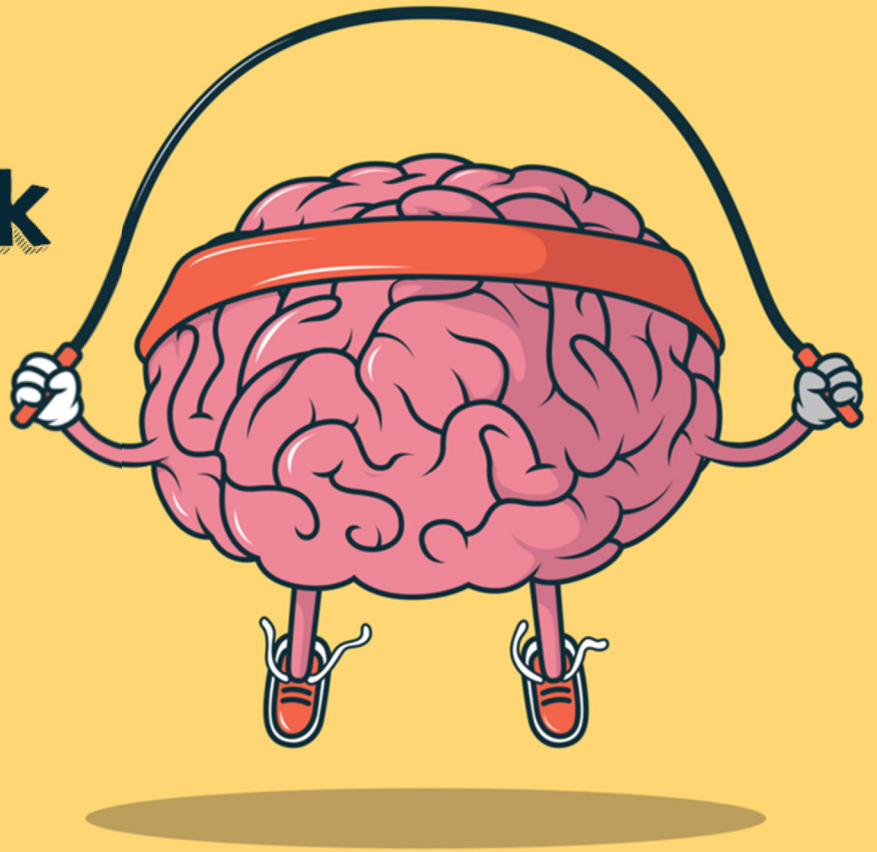

Literacy

This week in our Literacy lesson, the children will be focusing on describing characters using adjectives and similes. The children will look at the function of adjectives and similes and will begin to use them in their own creative writing. In Phonics, the children will be looking at the 'oi' sound. At home, you can ask your child to think of different adjectives to describe things in their local area. You can also complete the assigned task on Reading Eggs.

Maths

This week in our Maths class, the children will be refining their skills in addition and will be solving worded addition problems. The children will be thinking about which strategies they can use to solve the problems and will be taking time to assess and critique their own work. At home, you can incorporate Maths into every day situations and can ask your child to solve a variety of worded addition problems.

Science

In our Science lesson, the children will begin to explore our new topic Electricity and Magnetism. The children will look at how electricity works and identify different sources of electricity. At home, you can guide your child to think about being safe with electricity and can make a poster to present in class.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will be looking at how toys have changed over time. At home, you can look at different toys from the past and can ask your child to verbally compare them to their own modern toys.
