Literacy

This week in our Literacy lessons, the children will be recapping past tense verbs, especially irregular verbs to recount what they did over the holiday. At home, encourage your child to identify verbs they recognise when reading their books, making a list of past and present tense verbs.

Maths

In our Maths Number, the children will revise addition methods to apply to problem solving scenarios. At home, give your child a set of addition sums, as well as worded problems, encourage them to work these out using a variety of strategies.

Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children will begin to look at our new topic 'Electricity and Magnetism'. They will learn what electricity is and identify how electricity travels, including renewable energy sources. At home, encourage your child to make a safety poster to help others understand the dangers and how to keep safe.

Project

In our Project lesson, the children will begin their new topic, 'Toys and Games'. They will learn and describe how a toy is made and works. At home, encourage your child to choose their favourite toys or game and write a description about how it works.
