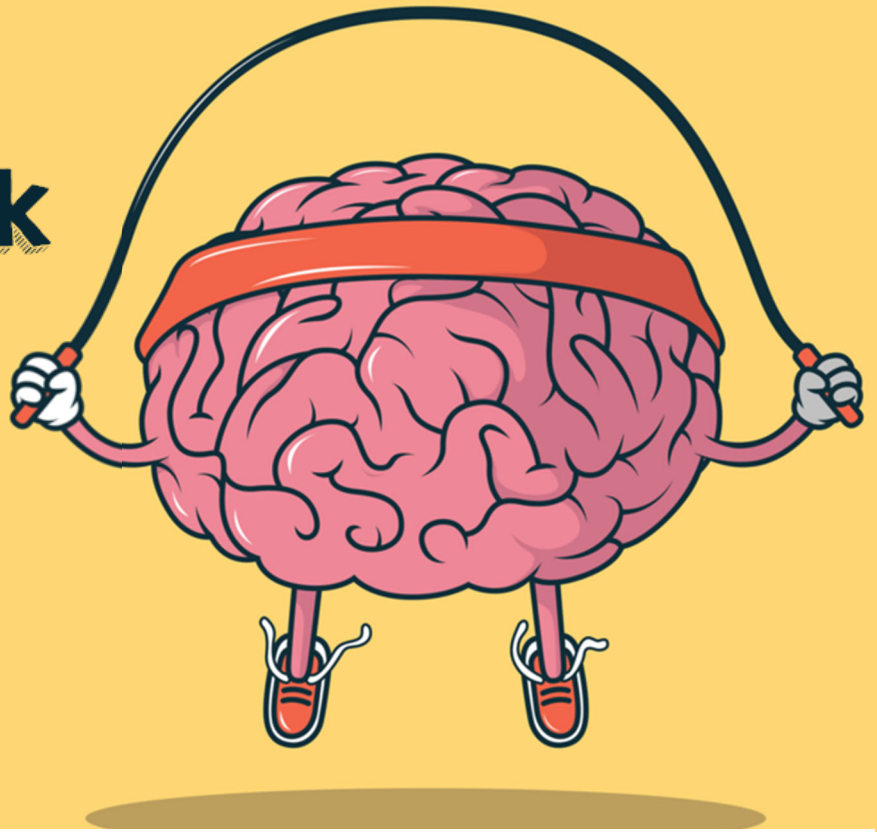

This week we are learning to...



Literacy

This week in our Literacy lesson, the children will be focusing on creating a newspaper report based on 'James and The Giant Peach' by Roald Dahl. The children will look at the function of speech marks, exclamation marks, adjectives and sentence openers. In Phonics, the children will be looking at the 'ear' and /air/ sounds. At home, you can ask your child to think of different adjectives to describe things in their local area. You can also complete the assigned task on Reading Eggs.

Maths

This week in our Maths class, the children will be continue learning about addition using pictorial representation. The children will be thinking about which strategies they can use to solve the problems and will be taking time to assess and critique their own work. At home, you can practise addition using concrete objects and then move to pictorial representation.

Science

In our Science lesson, the children will begin to explore our new topic 'Electricity and Magnetism'. The children will look at constructing a simple electrical circuit using light bulb. We will discuss what they observe, and predict what would happen if the circuit was not joined up. At home, you can create a drawing of a circuit with several light bulbs.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will be looking at recognising and comparing early 20th Century toys. The children will have the opportunity to look at the differences between these toys and our toys. At home, you can do a re-search of the most popular toys in the early 20th Century.
