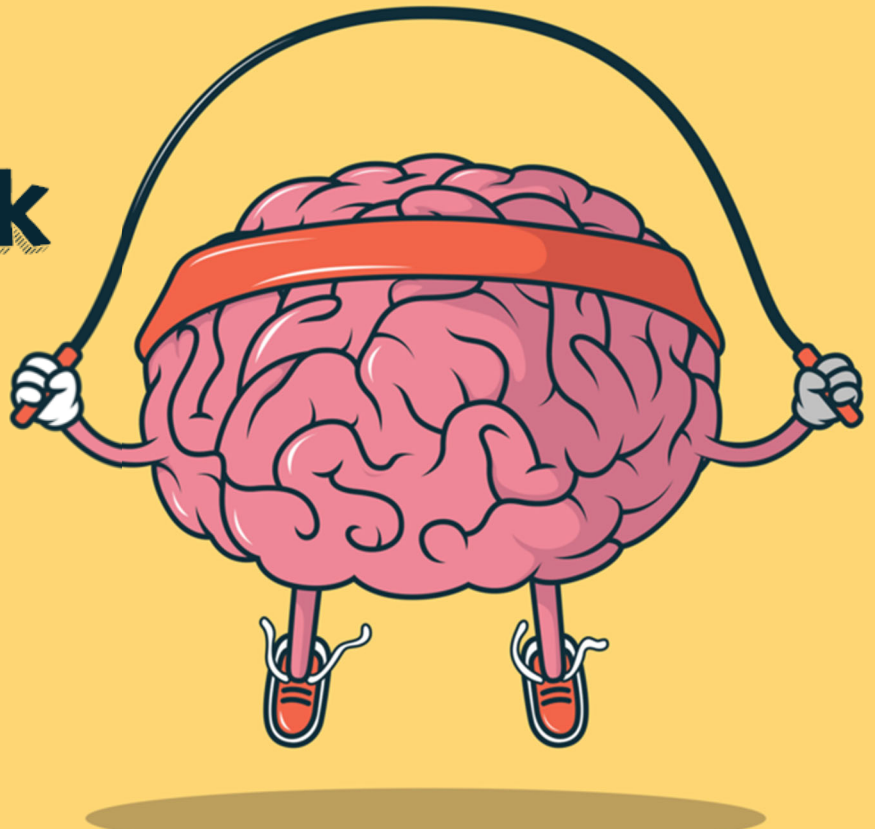

Literacy

This week in our Literacy lesson, the children will continue learning about 'James and The Giant Peach' by Roald Dahl. The children will create a recipe for Green Tiny Things with a set of instructions. In Phonics, the children will be looking at the /ay/ sound. At home, you can ask your child to look for different items with the /ay/ sound on them. You can also complete the assigned task on Reading Eggs.

Maths

This week in our Maths class, the children will continue learning about addition counting in 10's. The children will apply their knowledge of adding to see the patterns in 10 times table, using concrete and pictorial representation and knowledge of how to count in 10's. At home, you can practise addition using concrete objects and then move to pictorial representation.

Science

In our Science lesson, the children will continue exploring 'Magnetism'. The children will look at why magnets attract some things and not others. We will test materials to see which are magnetic, making predictions and conclusions. At home, you can select some items and test them, then you could also classifying them in those two groups.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will be looking at toys in the Victorian Era. The children will have the opportunity to look at the differences between these toys and our toys. At home, you can do a research of the most popular toys in the Victorian Era.
