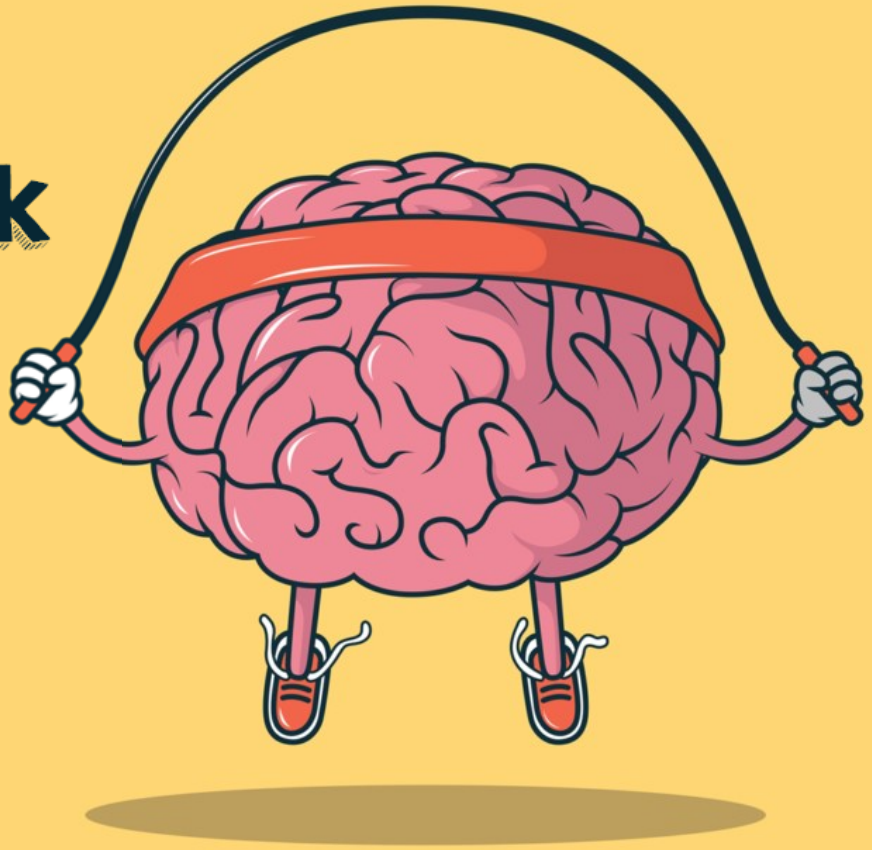

#### Maths:

This week in our Maths lesson, the children will refine their understanding of doubling numbers. The children will be solving worded problems and will use a variety of strategies to support them. In Maths Project, the children will learn how to use an analogue clock to tell the time on the hour. At home, you can practise drawing different hands on a clock and asking your child to tell the time.

#### Literacy:

This week in our Recount lesson, the children will practise using connectives in their writing. They will understand that connectives can be used to add in information, sequence ideas or events and compare. In Phonics, the children will look at the 'ue' sound and should suggest different words that have the 'ue' digraph. At home, you can continue to practise Phonics using Reading Eggs.

#### Science:

This week in our Science lesson, the children will look at the impact of Climate Change. The children will be thinking of ways to reduce Climate Change and will work together to create a short presentation. At home, you can discuss environmental issues with your child and ask them to suggest ways to protect the environment.

#### Project:

In our Project lesson, the children will look at toys from around the world. They will be researching popular toys in different countries and should be encouraged to continue their research at home. If you have toys from a different country, you are invited to bring these toys in and talk about them during Show and Tell.
