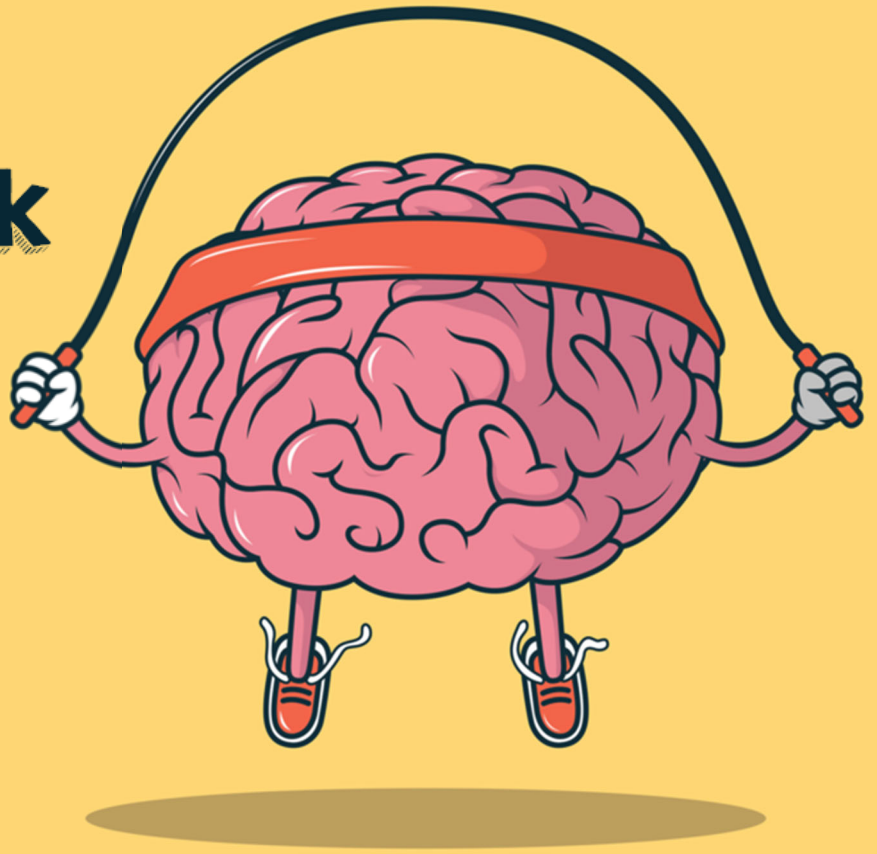

Maths:

This week in our Maths lesson, the children will refine their understanding of halving numbers. The children will be solving worded problems and will use a variety of strategies to support them. In Maths Project, we will continue learning about how to use an analogue clock to tell the time. The children will focus on how to tell quarter past on an analogue clock. At home, you can practise drawing different hands on a clock and asking your child to tell the time.

Literacy:

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will practise using adjectives and alliteration in their writing. Looking at the story, 'Three Little Monkeys' by Quentin Blake, they will understand how to write a detailed setting description. At home, your child can continue to practise descriptive settings trying to independently describe their own bedroom.

Science:

This week in our Science lesson, the children will look at how to identify where energy comes from. The children will be learning about that the energy comes from burning of fossil fuels such as coal, oil and natural gas. At home, you can look at and research about an alternative energy called renewable energy.

Project:

In our Project lesson, the children will look at what sort of games people play around the world. They will be comparing games from other countries and games in the UK. At home, your child could write down ideas of how to improve one of their favourite games.
