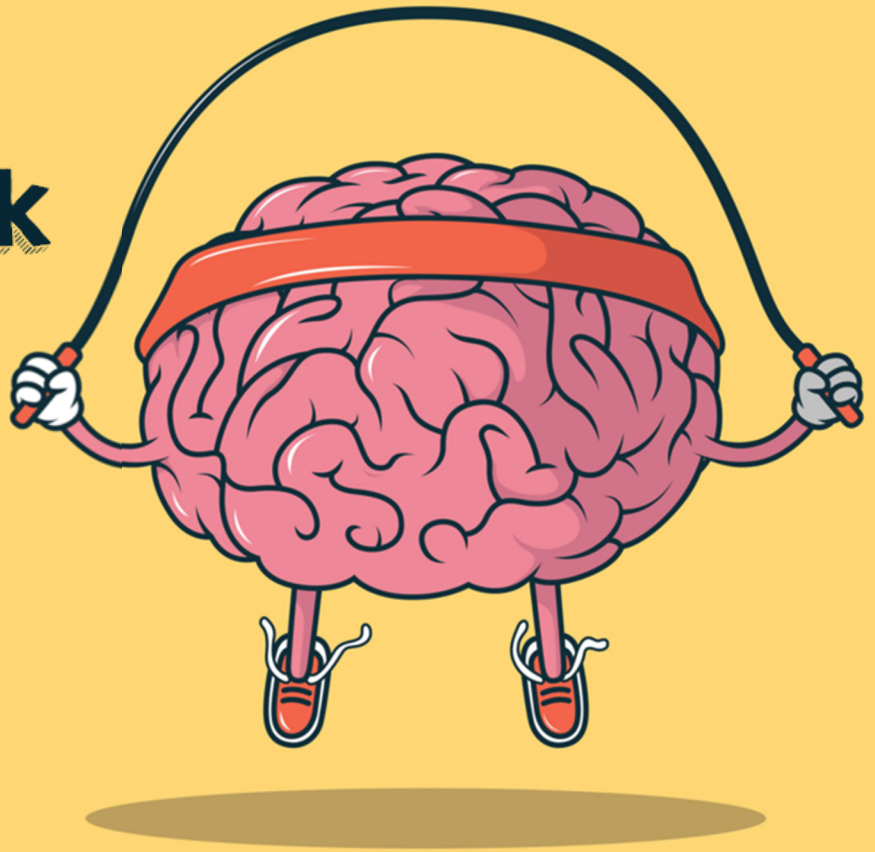

Maths:

This week in our Maths lesson, the children will work on subtraction sentences using number lines. The children will be working on subtraction using concrete objects, using appropriate language such as subtract and take away. In Maths Project, we will continue learning about how to use an analogue clock to tell the time. The children will focus on how to tell the hour and the quarter past on an analogue clock. At home, you can set a clock and ask your child to guess the time.

Literacy:

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will continue practising using adjectives and alliteration in their writing. Looking again at the story, 'Three Little Monkeys' by Quentin Blake, they will write a report of the mess created by the Little Monkeys. At home, your child can describe your garden or nearby park.

Science:

This week in our Science lesson, the children will look at Sustainability. The children will be learning about the impact caused by waste. They will also discuss why some materials are chosen for packaging based on their properties. At home, you can look at ways that glass, food, paper is recycled.

Project:

In our Project lesson, the children will look at what impact do our toys have on the environment. They will be exploring alternatives/solutions to these environmental issues. At home, your child could compare the environmental impact of modern toys, and toys from different moments of our history.
