This week we are learning to...

Project

As we begin this term we introduce the Hedgehogs' class to our new project on 'Transport'. We will be looking for the children to show confidence and independence in using resources as well as acknowledging the other children around them. We will be exploring all the different modes of transport from around the world, looking at the different ways they move. To support this, you could see what transport you see on your way to and from school.

Literacy

The Hedgehogs' class will be introduced to some new and some familiar stories this week as we familiarise the children with routine and expectations, as well as getting used to sitting together with their peers. The story of the week will be 'Superworm', by Julia Donaldson. We will be exploring the use of songs alongside the stories to encourage repetition and use of rhyme, building on their communication and language. You can encourage this at home by using some of the songs we use at school, such as "How are you today" using Makaton signs!

Personal, social and emotional development

Every Friday the children are encouraged to bring something personal to them from home to share with their peers at school. This is to support their personal development as well as their communication and language. At home, you can support your child in choosing something and prompt them with some questions about this. We hope to see progress in this as we go through the term.
