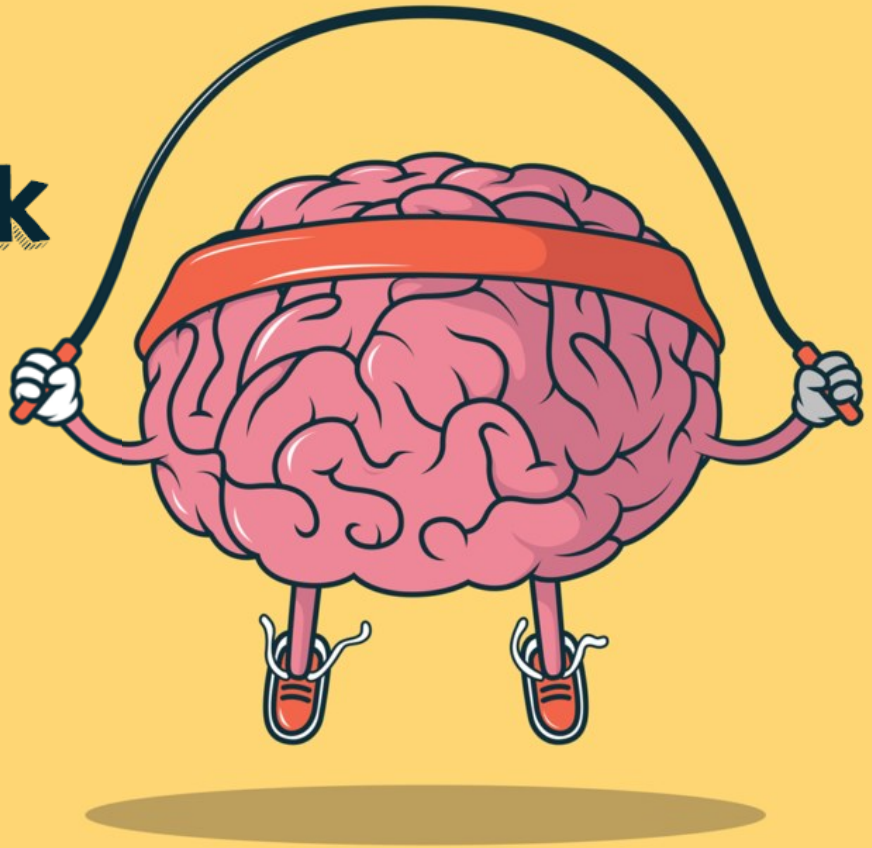

Literacy:

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will be exploring nouns. They will be wearing their green thinking hats to create their own shopping lists and will be required to use their knowledge of phonics to sound out and write CVC words. At home, ask your child to write a shopping list for the weekend and use this to support you for your weekly shop! In Phonics, the children will be refining their understanding of rhyming words. At home, you can scatter a selection of words on the table and ask your child to read and sort them into rhyming pairs.

Maths:

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will continue to work on counting from 1-30 and will identify which number lies between two given numbers. In our Maths Project lesson, the children will be wearing their white thinking hats and discussing the properties of different 2D shapes. At home, you can encourage your child to identify different shapes in the local environment and to discuss the properties of the shapes they see. Don't forget to take a photo and send it to us so we can display and discuss in class. Parents are also invited to log on to Maths Whiz to further practise Maths activities at home.

Science:

This week in our Science lesson, the children will identify the four seasons and months of the year in which they occur. At home, encourage your child to begin investigating what they can observe happening when we change from summer to autumn.

Project:

This week in our Project lesson, the children will understand and explain what makes a person famous. They will be thinking about famous people they know and will be discussing reasons why they are famous. At home, encourage your child to explore significant people who have contributed to the modern world we live in. We look forward to hearing all about this in our Project class!
