Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, the children will practice using adverbs within their writing. In their writing the children will reflect on their weekend using adverbs to help describe the events. At home, encourage your child to identify adverbs as they are reading with you. Once they have identified these adverbs they can use them in their own writing.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will be studying rounding numbers. We will identify the Golden Rule of Rounding which is that if the digit is five or more, we round up. For example: 36 would become 40. If the digit is less than 5, you round down. For example: 32 would become 30. We will apply this along with our knowledge of place value to rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. We will approach rounding to the nearest whole number. At home, use walking talking maths opportunities to practise rounding as your child is doing their daily activities on the weekend.

Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their investigation of the weather. This week, we will explore the different weather found during the different seasons, explaining which month each season occurs in and identify the weather. We will focus on our current season of Autumn. We will identify common weather types during this season as well as changes we can see in nature. As part of this we shall explore the changing leaves of deciduous trees contrasting them to evergreen trees. We will run an experiment into how some plants—disperse their seeds during this season. At home, your child can make a poster of the—different seasons identifying weather types and differences between the seasons.
