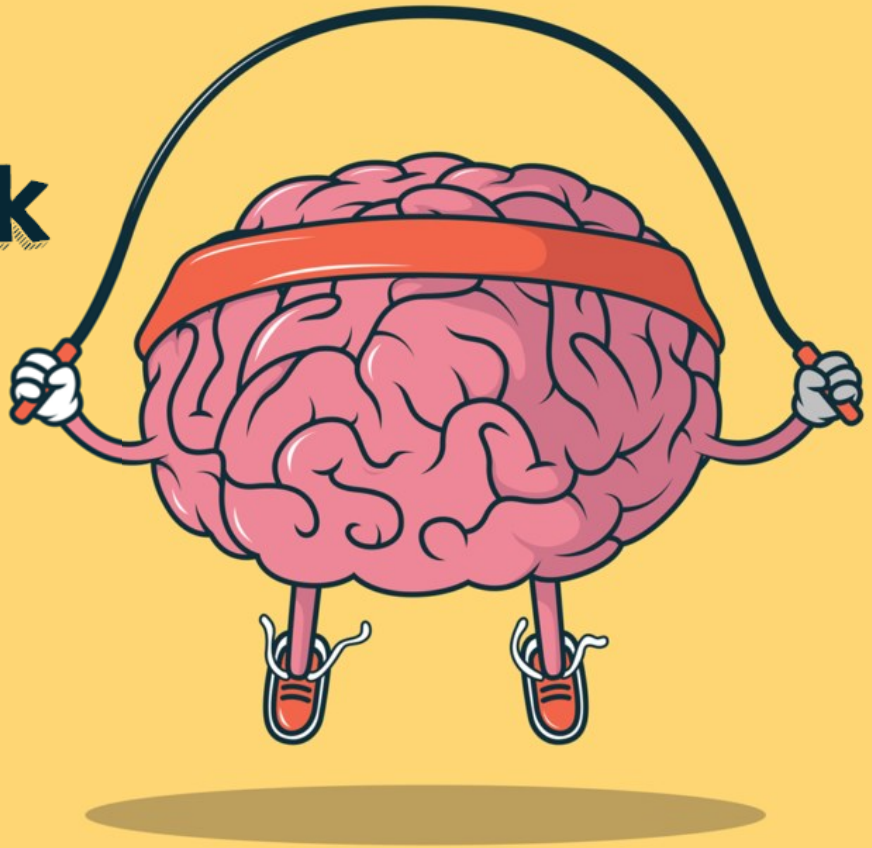

This week we are learning to...



Literacy:

This week in our Recount lesson, the children will be learning to identify different verbs/ action words and will write their own verbs in their independent sentences. In our Creative Writing lesson, the children will be thinking about their dream camping trip and will create a list of the items they will take. At home, you can practise recognising verbs and nouns with your child through asking them to sort different words into a categorising thinking frame. In Phonics, our sounds of the week are x and y and we encourage all children to complete the assigned task on Reading Eggs.

Maths:

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will be looking at number bonds to 10. The children will use concrete objects to look at different ways of making 10 and are encouraged to use blocks at home to further practise. In Maths Project, the children will continue to explore symmetry and will be creating their own symmetrical object.

Science:

In our Science lesson, the children will be exploring the water cycle. At home, encourage your child to conduct their own rain water experiment by filling a clear cup with water. Then, add a layer of shaving cream with several drops of blue food colouring. Your child should observe that the 'cloud' gets too heavy and rain will soon start to fall.

Project:

In our Project lesson, the children will understand and explain the differences between a famous figure and a non-famous figure. At home, ask your child to think of a famous person and ask them to explain how they are different to an infamous person.

Philosophy/Metacognition:

In our Philosophy lesson this week, the children will discuss the consequences of bad actions and will delve into the thinking question 'does doing a bad thing make you a bad person?' At home, it is important to engage in meaningful conversations and to encourage your child to wear their six thinking hats to discuss their reasoning.
