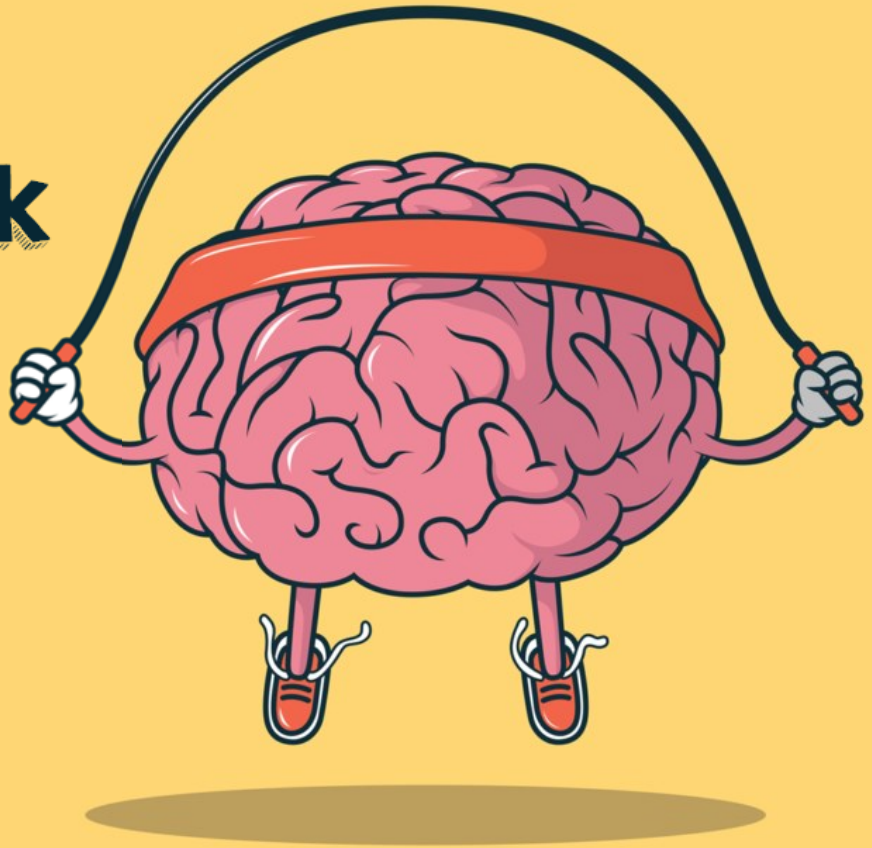

Maths:

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will start to look at simple addition. The children will be using concrete objects to practise adding two numbers together and will work with a partner to check their answers. At home, you can practise adding different toys together and ask your child to solve simple addition problems.

Literacy:

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will learn about adjectives and how to use them to enhance their writing. At home, you can ask your child to think of different adjectives they can use to describe people they are familiar with as well as their local environment. We also encourage children to read daily at home in order to develop their independent reading skills.

Science:

This week in our Science lesson, the children will explore which type of weather is good for flying, recreating a model of an aeroplane to test it out throughout the week and make a conclusion. At home, encourage your child to research and compare the Wright Brother aeroplane to a modern aeroplane.

Project:

This week in our Project lesson, the children will understand and explain why Elizabeth I and King Henry VIII are famous. At home, encourage your child to explain why they are significant in history and consider whether they are famous or infamous figures.
