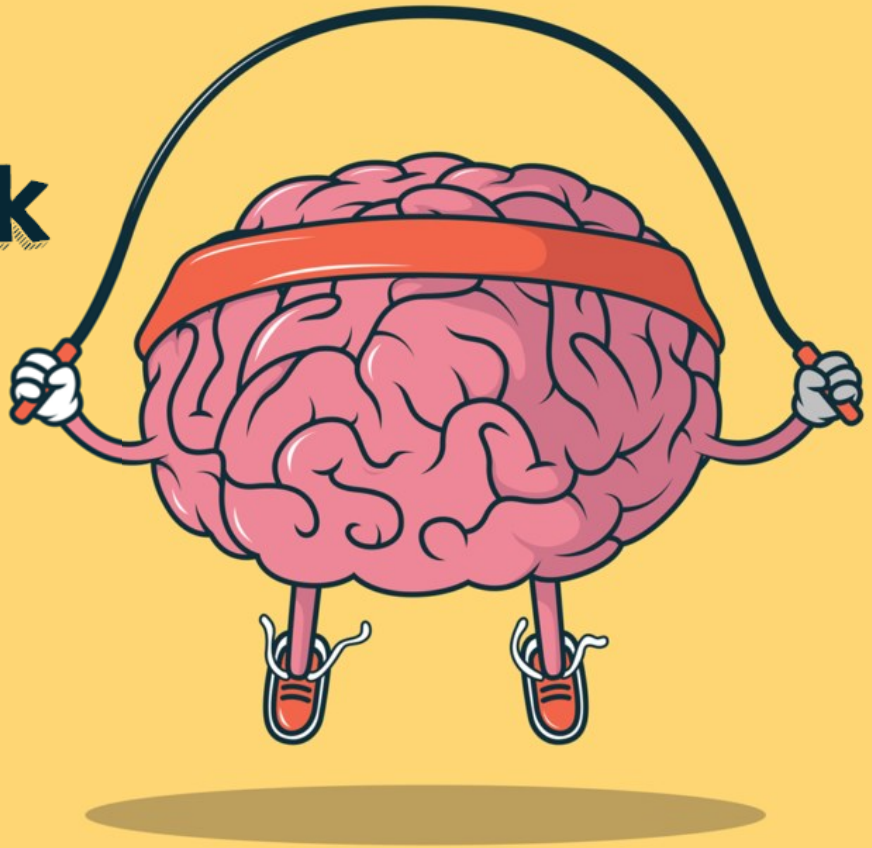

learning
to...**



Literacy:

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will continue to explore and use adjectives to enhance their work. They will be transformed to a frozen landscape and will engage all of their senses to write a descriptive piece of text. At home, you can find a picture of a landscape and ask your child to create a defining thinking frame to list as many adjectives to describe the picture as they can. In Phonics, our sound of the week is 'zz' and children are encouraged to complete the Reading Eggs challenge as well as read one of the story books on Reading Eggspress.

Maths:

This week in our Maths Project lesson, the children will be familiarising themselves with the months of the year and will practise putting them in the correct order. In Maths Number, the children will be learning about number bonds and will be using concrete objects to create different ways of making 10. At home, you can create a number bond model using paper plates.

Science:

This week in our Science lesson, the children will learn about different clouds and will identify the characteristics of the clouds we experience in the UK. (cirrus, stratus, cumulus and cumulonimbus) At home, encourage your child to observe the different clouds they see in the week, explaining what type of weather we expect from each cloud.

Project:

This week in our Project lesson, the children will understand and explain why Neil Armstrong and Katherine Johnson are famous. At home, encourage your child to wear their white thinking hats and to discuss the facts they discover to their family members at home.

Metacognition/Philosophy:

In our Philosophy lesson this week, we will be having an in-depth conversation about fairness. The children will be discussing the difference between fair and unfair and we encourage children to engage in deeper discussions at home in order to develop their thinking and communication skills.
