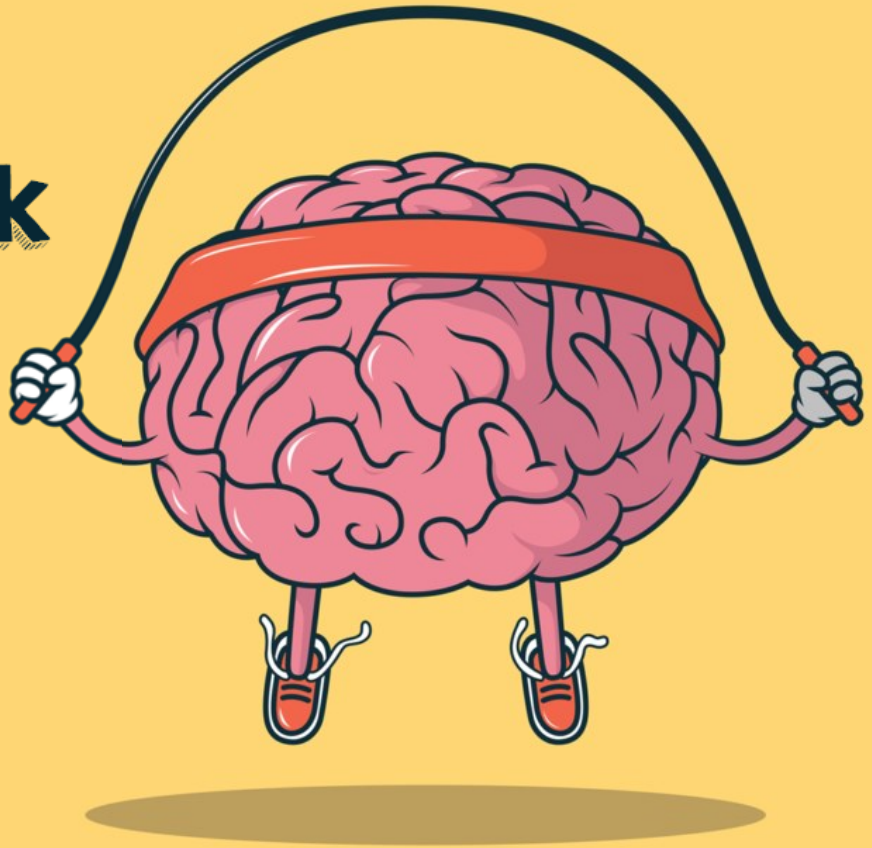

This week we are learning to...



Literacy:

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will learn how to use alliteration in their work. The children will wear their green thinking hats to create a piece of writing about zoo animals and will assess the effectiveness of using alliteration. At home, ask your child to identify examples of alliteration in the stories you read together.

Maths:

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will be looking at subtraction and will use the various tools in their 'big thinking toolbox' to support them with solving simple subtraction questions. At home, you can use concrete objects to practise both addition and subtraction questions with your child.

Science:

This week in our Science lesson, the children will be wearing their yellow thinking hats and discussing the importance and benefits of sustainability. They will be learning how waste can impact our environment and will work with the Creative Camel to think of ways to reduce waste at school and at home. At home, ask your child to think of ways to reduce waste at home and create a plan of action for the family to follow.

Project:

This week in our Project lesson, the children will explore the famous works of Leonardo Da Vinci. At home, encourage your child to wear their red thinking hats and to look at and explain how Da Vinci's work makes them feel.

Metacognition/Philosophy:

In our Metacognition lesson, the children will be learning about decision making. At home, involve your child in different decisions and ask them to verbally explain the reasons for their decision.
