Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, the children will use coordinating conjunctions in their writing. A coordinating conjunction is a conjunction that connects words, phrases, and clauses that are coordinate, or equal to each other. There are seven coordinating conjunctions: for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so. At home, encourage your child to use coordinating conjunctions in their own writing.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will be studying how to add and subtract decimals. We will use column method and apply carrying and borrow and payback strategies to adding and subtracting decimals. At home, encourage your child to practise adding and subtracting decimals when they are out shopping. This is a great chance for walking talking maths and to grow self-confidence when buying from the shop assistants.

Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their explorations of the weather. This week we will study different types of weather. We will study the different types of weather focusing on inclement weather. We will examine the negative affects of such weather and the consequences thereupon. We will conduct an experiment into tornadoes and then reflect upon what we have discovered. At home, encourage your child to conduct further research into such inclement weather types.
