## **Literacy**

In our writing lessons this week, the children will use practice adding exciting sentence starters to their sentences. We will continue to practise using paragraphs in our writing, understanding that we start a new paragraph when we start a new topic or idea. We will start each new paragraph with an exciting paragraph starter. At home, encourage your child to use exciting sentence and paragraph starters in their own writing; such as anxiously and almost unbelievably.

## Maths

In Maths this week, the children will be studying how to balance equations. We will examine the rule of balancing equations understanding that the rule is that both sides of the equation must equal the same. We will understand the importance of showing our workings out and checking our work using the inverse. At home, encourage your child to practise balancing equations through walking talking maths opportunities.

## Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their explorations of the weather. This week we will study the characteristics of clouds. We will study that clouds are given different names based on their shape and their height in the sky. Some clouds are puffy like cotton while others are grey and uniform. Some clouds are near the ground, while others are further up in the sky. At home, encourage your child to conduct further research into how clouds are formed.
