Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, children will reflect on their weekend and use speech marks in their writing, remembering that speech marks show us where direct speech starts and ends. We will focus on punctuating speech properly. At home, encourage your child to draw a graphic novel and use speech bubbles to write what the characters are saying, using speech marks appropriately.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will be studying how to compare numbers. We will examine the rule of comparing numbers. We will be able to explain how two numbers are different using vocabulary such as greater than and less than. At home, encourage your child to compare numbers using the given terminology through walking talking maths opportunities.

Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their explorations of the weather. This week we will study the characteristics of clouds. We will study that clouds are given different names based on their shape and their height in the sky. Some clouds are puffy like cotton while others are grey and uniform. Some clouds are near the ground, while others are further up in the sky. We will conduct an experiment into cloud formation. At home, encourage your child to conduct further research into how clouds are formed.
