Understanding the world

The Hedgehogs' class are going to be diving into Book Week! The class will be doing lots of lessons based on the story 'Angelica Sprocket's Pockets' by Quentin Blake. At home, you can create a costume with your child of their favourite book character for our book parade on Friday. For Show and Tell the children can bring in their favourite story too.

Maths

This week, the Hedgehogs' class will be continuing the theme from the story 'Angelica Sprocket's Pockets' by Quentin Blake. They will be categorising objects in order of size, counting out these items from 0-5 and putting them a piles of 'big' and a pile of 'small'. At home, you could use objects such as blocks to continue their learning.

Literacy

This week the children will be drawing the different characters from the story 'Angelica Sprocket's Pockets' by Quentin Blake. The children will be looking at the features and characteristics of the characters too. The class will also be trying to think of their own ending to the story and answer the question 'what do you think happens next?' We will be continuing to encourage the children to use the pinching crab technique to hold the pencil with their thumb and first two fingers.
