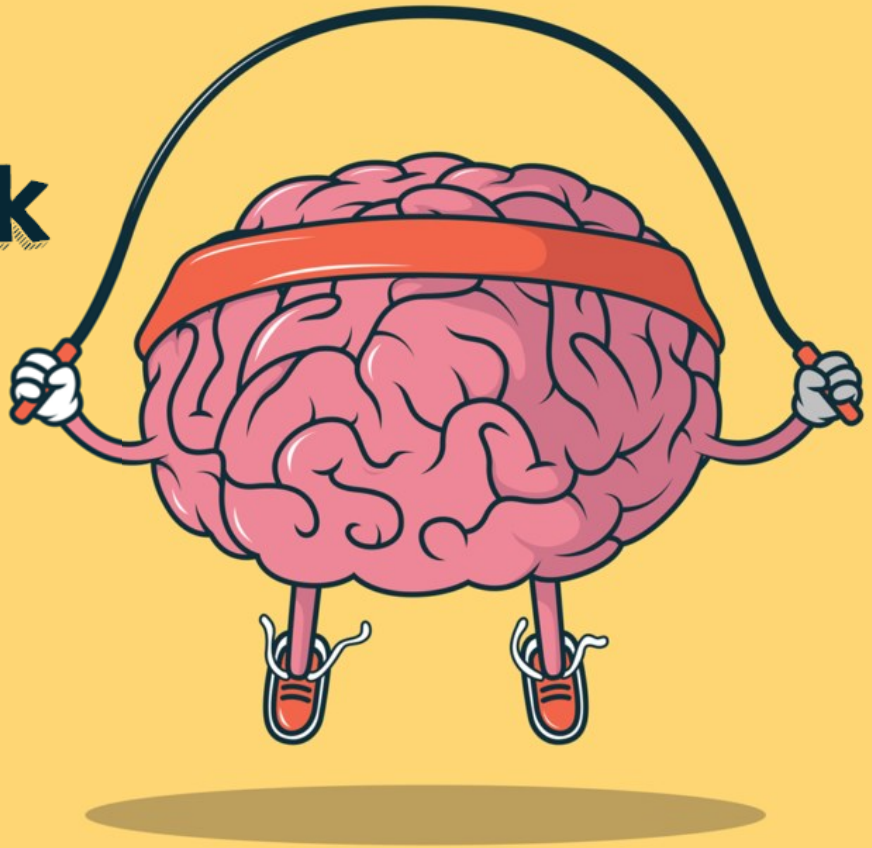

Literacy:

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will be putting on their green thinking hats and creating an acrostic poem about Winter. The children will be exploring how to create poems that excite the reader and will be working with their friends to evaluate each other's work. At home, encourage your child to create an acrostic poem using the letters of their name.

Maths:

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will continue to look at place value and will develop their understanding of partitioning numbers into tens, ones and hundreds. At home, you can continue to utilise Purple Mash to practise partitioning numbers. In Maths Project, the children will learn how to recognise and sort coins. They will be ordering coins from the smallest to highest value and will be challenged to purchase items in their role-play shop. At home, encourage your child to use coins to buy items from the shop.

Science:

This week in our Science lesson, the children will look at water pollution and will wear their purple thinking hats to discuss the negative impact caused. At home, encourage your child to come up with solutions to solve the water pollution crisis. They can use the internet to complete a research project and are invited to share their findings with their friends.

Project:

This week in our Project lesson, the children will understand and explain why Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole were famous. At home, encourage your child to write a comparison of their roles during the Crimean War.

Metacognition:

In our Metacognition class, the children will look at our very own Resilient Waterbear. Our Resilient Waterbear likes to persevere, when things go wrong he carries on, even if it seemed unclear." At home, encourage your child to discuss which mindset they used at school.
