Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, children will reflect on their weekend and use commas in their writing. We will use commas to indicate a pause in our writing. We will also use commas to show lists. When writing a list, you should put a comma between each item, except for the last item where you use 'and'. For example: "I need to go to the supermarket to buy eggs, milk, bread, sugar and orange juice." At home, encourage your child to use commas in their own writing, for instance, when writing their weekly spelling sentences.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will be exploring prime numbers. We will be applying our multiplication and division skills to understand what a prime number is. A prime number is a number that can only be divided by itself and 1 without remainders. At home, encourage your child to practise their times tables and reflect on which answers are prime numbers.

Science

In Science this week, the children will explore the water cycle. We will conduct an experiment to explore the substances that help change the state of matter of water. We will make predictions before the experiment takes place and then make conclusions based on our observations, using this scientific terminology. At home, encourage your child to visit the Science Museum to explore how the water cycle works.
