Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, the children will study how to use subordinating conjunctions appropriately. A subordinating conjunction is a word or phrase that links a dependent clause to an independent clause. This word or phrase indicates that a clause has informative value to add to the sentence's main idea, signalling a cause-and-effect relationship or a shift in time and place between the two clauses. We will practise using subordinating conjunctions through writing a recount of our weekend. At home, why not try encouraging your child to enrich their writing by using the above grammar as part of a journal entry documenting their week.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will consider what is budget and profit. The children will define budget and profit, consider how to plan for sticking to a budget and consider how to enhance their profit. At home, why not try encourage your child to come up with a business proposal such as a lemonade stand.

Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their new project about Materials! We will examine the absorbency of different materials through an engaging experiment. The children will collect the data from their experiments and draw conclusions reflecting upon what they have observed. At home, why not encourage your child to identify the different properties of the materials in their home.
