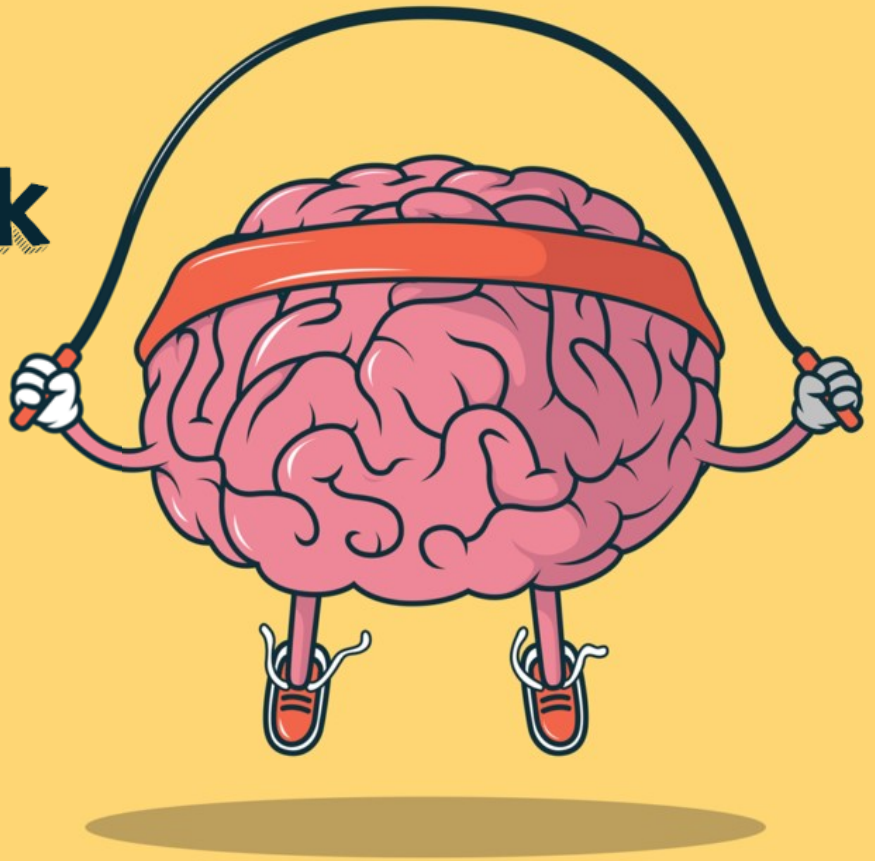

This week we are learning to...



Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, the children will study how to use prefixes to make their writing more effective and descriptive. Prefixes are one- to three-syllable affixes added to the beginning of a base word to slightly change its meaning. For example, adding the prefix im- to the base word possible creates a new word, impossible, which means “not possible”. At home, why not try encouraging your child to enrich their writing by using the above grammar as part of a journal entry documenting their week.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will approach solving number sequences including the Fibonacci sequence. They will follow the steps to solve number sequences. They will first identify the pattern in a sequence. Then, they will use this to complete the sequence. Then, they will check their answer carefully. At home, why not use walking talking mathematics opportunities to solve number sequences.

Science

In Science this week, the children will investigate the properties of different materials considering what makes them suitable for constructing buildings. The children will design a flood proof house and then reflect on the results and adjust their plans accordingly. At home, why not encourage your child to explore the different building materials that are present in their home.
