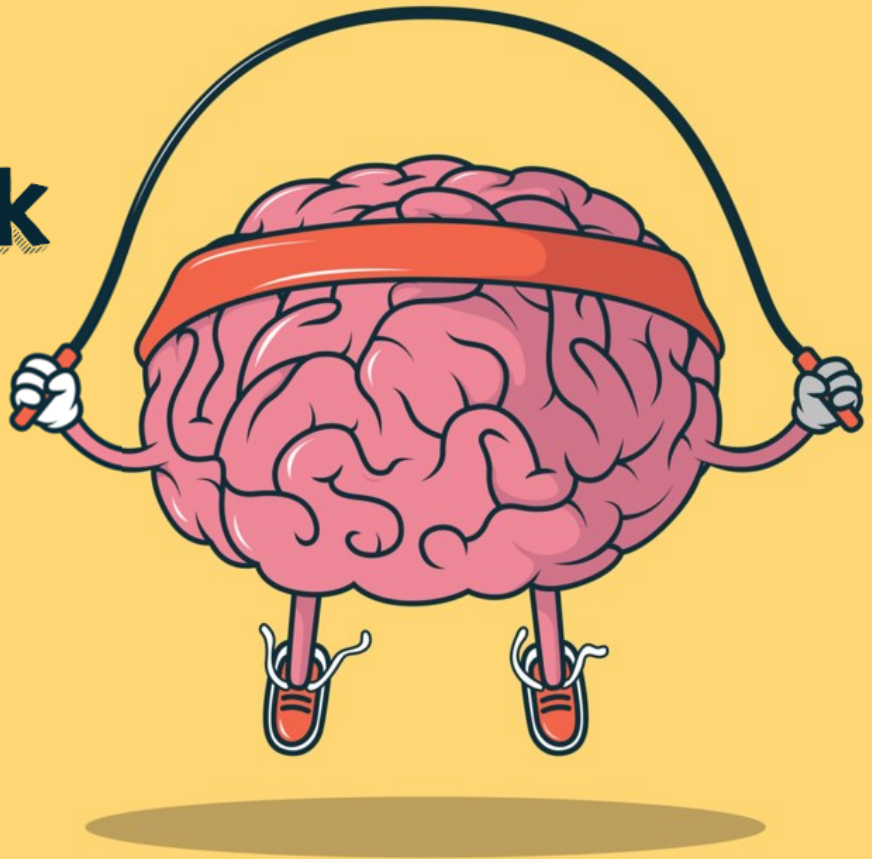

Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, the children will study how to use causal conjunctions in their writing. Causal conjunctions are words and phrases which are used to introduce a cause, reason or explanation for a given action within a sentence. For instance 'because of', 'due to' and 'as a consequence of' are all causal conjunctions which link an action to its supposed cause. They will be using causal conjunctions to write a recount of their weekend. At home, why not try encouraging your child to enrich their writing by using the above grammar as part of a journal entry documenting their week.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will consider written strategies to solve complex multiplication problems. They will solve multi-steps word problems and will use learned methods to calculate their answer. At home, encourage your child to practice their multiplication facts.

Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their new project about Materials! We will examine how waterproof different materials are through an engaging experiment. The children will collect the data from their experiments and draw conclusions reflecting upon what they have observed. At home, why not encourage your child to identify the different properties of the materials in their home.
