Maths

This week, the Hedgehogs' class will be comparing the lengths of objects using vocabulary such as 'big' and 'small'. At home, you could support your child's learning by providing a variety of objects and asking them to put them in size order, from biggest to smallest.

Literacy

In the Hedgehogs' class this week, the children will be drawing self portraits using mark making tools. At home you can support your child with practising their tripod grip. The children will be describing their features and their body parts using key vocabulary such as: head, shoulders, knees, toes, ears, nose, eyes and mouth. At home, you can encourage your child to point to different parts of their body, a great way to do this is through the rhyme, "Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes".

Understanding the World

This week, will be looking to support our fine motor skills, following the story 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' by Peter Christen Asbjornsen, the Hedgehogs' class will be given the task to construct their own bridge for the goats to cross. Using a variety of construction material, we will look for the children's ability to connect materials together as well as their problem solving and perseverance. Allowing the children to complete tasks with little or no support will give the children the chance to problem solve and improve their patience. At home, you could look at constructing towers. Can they count how many blocks in their tower?
