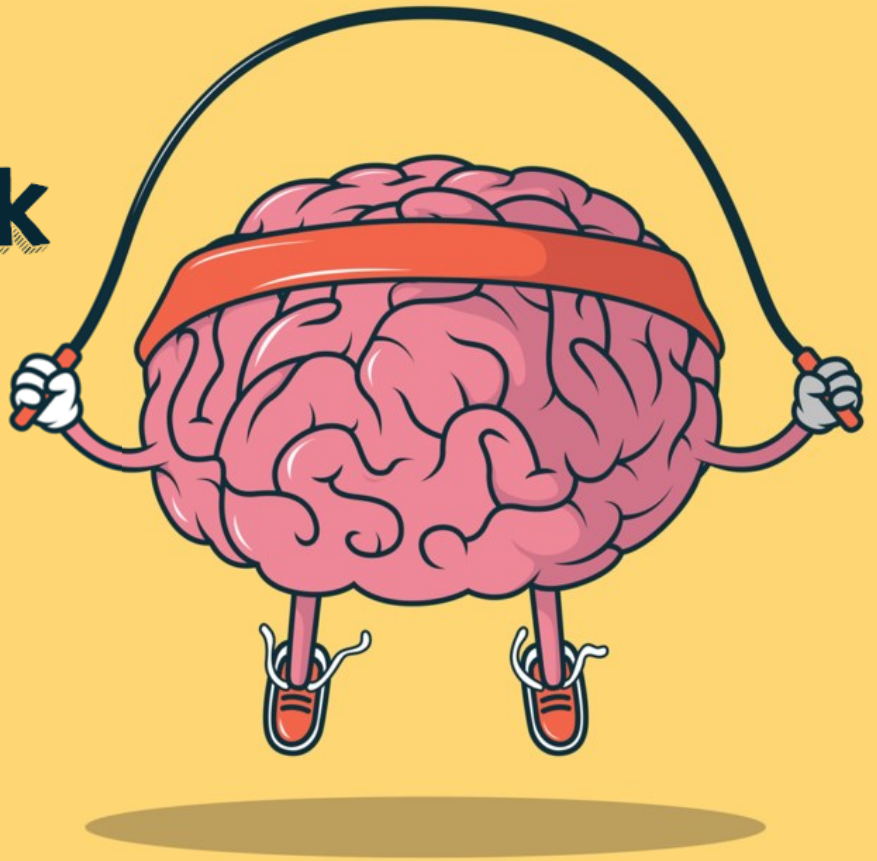

### Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, the children will study how to use suffixes to make their writing more effective and descriptive. Suffixes are one or more letters added to the end of a base word to change its conjugation, word type, or other grammar properties like plurality. For example, you can add the suffix -s to the noun strength to make it plural (strengths) or add the suffix -en to turn it into a verb (strengthen). At home, why not try encouraging your child to enrich their writing by using the above grammar as part of a journal entry documenting their week.

### Maths

In Maths this week, the children will approach solving complex worded problems. They will follow the RUCSAC method to solve these worded problems. They will use the vocabulary to identify which operation to use. The children will work strategically through the sum and use the inverse to check their answer. At home, encourage your child to make their own word problems, solve them, and then challenge family members and friends to solve them.

### Science

In Science this week, the children will explore climate change and its effects on our planet. They will define some of the causes and effects of climate change and then offer possible practical solutions to climate change. At home, why not take your child to visit the Museum of Climate Hope in Oxford?
