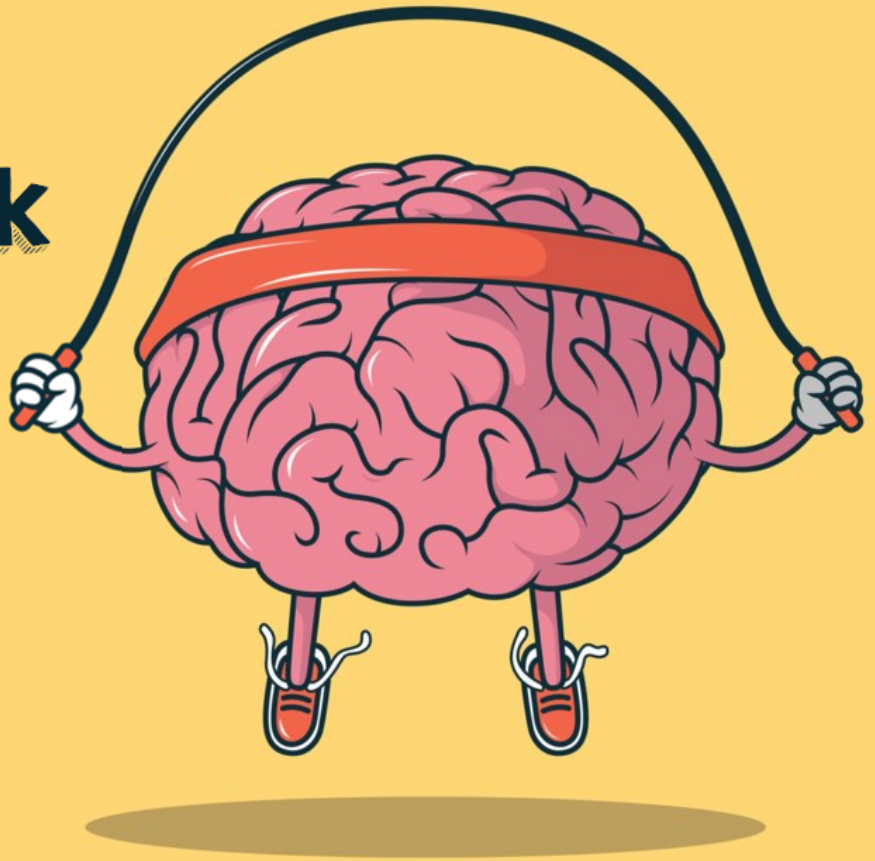

Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, the children will practise using the indefinite article in their writing. The two indefinite articles in English are a and an. The indefinite article an is used to make pronunciation easier when reading a text aloud. The general rule is to use a when the indefinite article precedes a word beginning with a consonant sound and an when it precedes a word starting with a vowel sound. At home, why not try encouraging your child to enrich their writing by using the above grammar as part of a journal entry documenting their week.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will practise using learned strategies to answer complex worded problems involving all four operations. We will use the RUCSAC method to identify the correct approach. At home, encourage your child to make their own worded problems, solve them, and then challenge family members and friends to solve them.

Science

In Science this week, the children will explore sustainability and the importance of looking after our planet. The children will explore the role of the United Nations Climate Change Conference in protecting our world. The children will take on the role of representatives at this conference and, after researching and planning out their position, will present their arguments to the rest of their peers. At home, why not encourage your child to conduct further research into sustainability.
