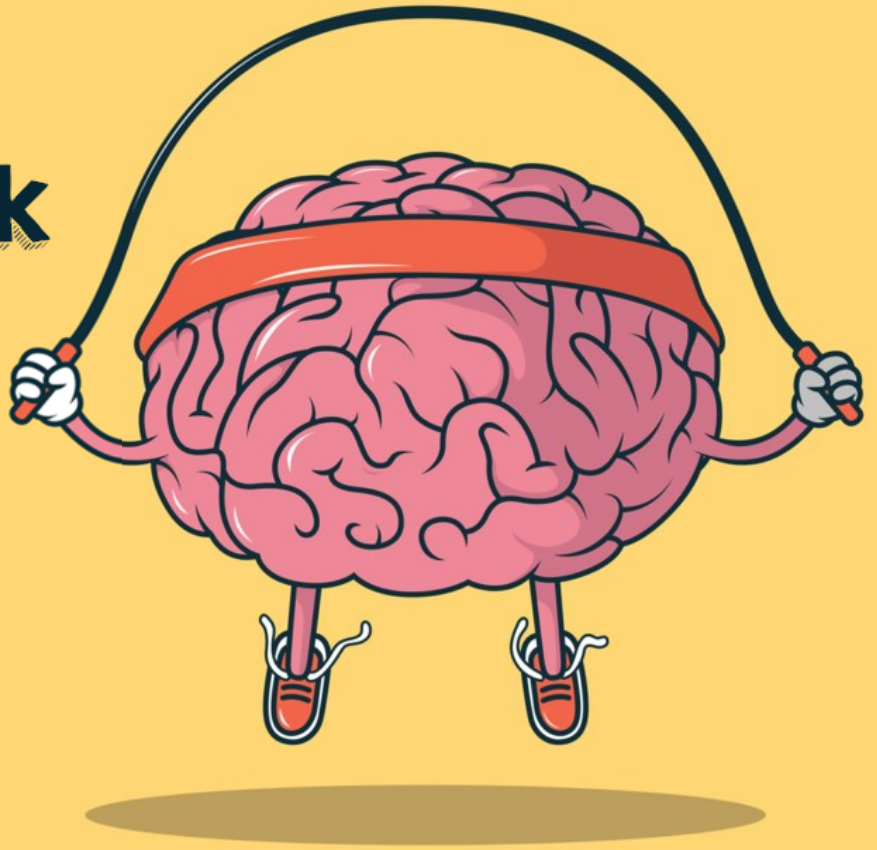

Literacy

This week in our Literacy lessons, the children will continue to recap past tense verbs, both irregular and regular verbs. At home, encourage your child to identify verbs they recognise when reading their books, making a list of past and present tense verbs and to challenge themselves to write sentences using these.

Maths

In our Maths Number, the children will revise subtraction methods to apply to problem solving scenarios. At home, give your child a set of subtraction sums, as well as worded problems, encourage them to work these out using a variety of strategies.

Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children will learn how plants grow, looking at the meaning of germination. At home, encourage your child to research different types of plants that we eat, they can present their findings on a PowerPoint or as a poster on paper.

Project

In our Project lesson, the children will understand how city states and different forms of government formed in Ancient Greece. At home, encourage your child to discuss how Athens and Sparta differed from one another.
