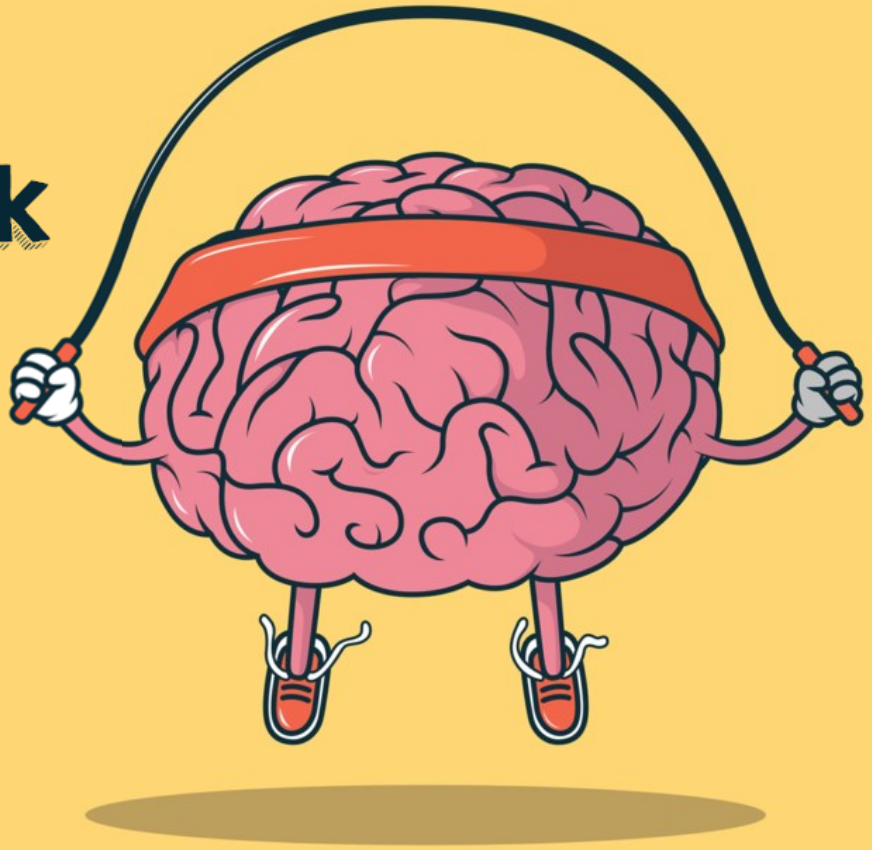

Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will be exploring verbs. They will learn how to use verbs in their creative writing and will be wearing yellow thinking hats to think about how verbs make the text more engaging. At home, you can write down a selection of nouns and verbs and ask your child to sort them into two groups. In Phonics, the children will be looking at rhyming words.

Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will continue to work on counting from 1-20 and will identify which number lies between two given numbers. In our Maths Project lesson, the children will be wearing their white thinking hats and discussing the properties of different 2D shapes, regular and irregular shapes. At home, you can encourage your child to identify different shapes in the local environment and to discuss the properties of the shapes they see.

Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children have begun a new topic on Forces and Magnetism. The children will learn how and why objects change shape when force is applied. At home, encourage your child to collect items they find around the house or garden and to experiment what happens to the shape of each item when they apply the following forces: squeeze, twist and stretch.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will compare and contrast Victorian schools to the present day. At home, encourage your child to draw how they think the Victorian uniform was.
