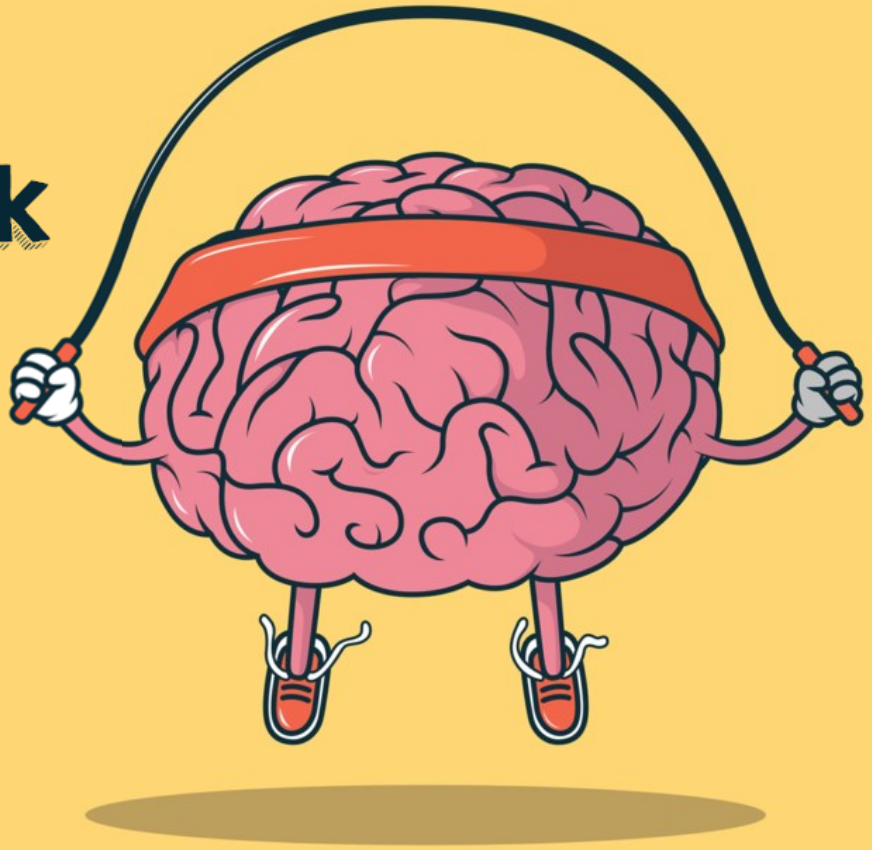

This week we are learning to...



Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will start to look at simple addition. The children will be using concrete objects to practise adding two numbers together and will work with a partner to check their answers. At home, you can practise adding different toys together and ask your child to solve simple addition problems.

Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will learn about adjectives and how to use them to enhance their writing. At home, you can ask your child to think of different adjectives they can use to describe people they are familiar with, as well as their local environment. We also encourage children to read daily at home in order to develop their independent reading skills.

Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children will explore what friction is and how it affects us in our everyday lives. At home, encourage your child to select three materials to conduct an experiment to find out which materials produced the most amount of frictions and how they know. Remember to make a prediction before conducting the experiment!

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will discover and compare living conditions then and now in different types of housing e.g. wealthy people versus back to back housing. At home, encourage your child to observe your street. Is the street a Victorian style street? Are the houses modern or old? Are all the streets the same width? What workplaces can you see? Are these homes for the rich or poor? How many rooms do you think each home has?
