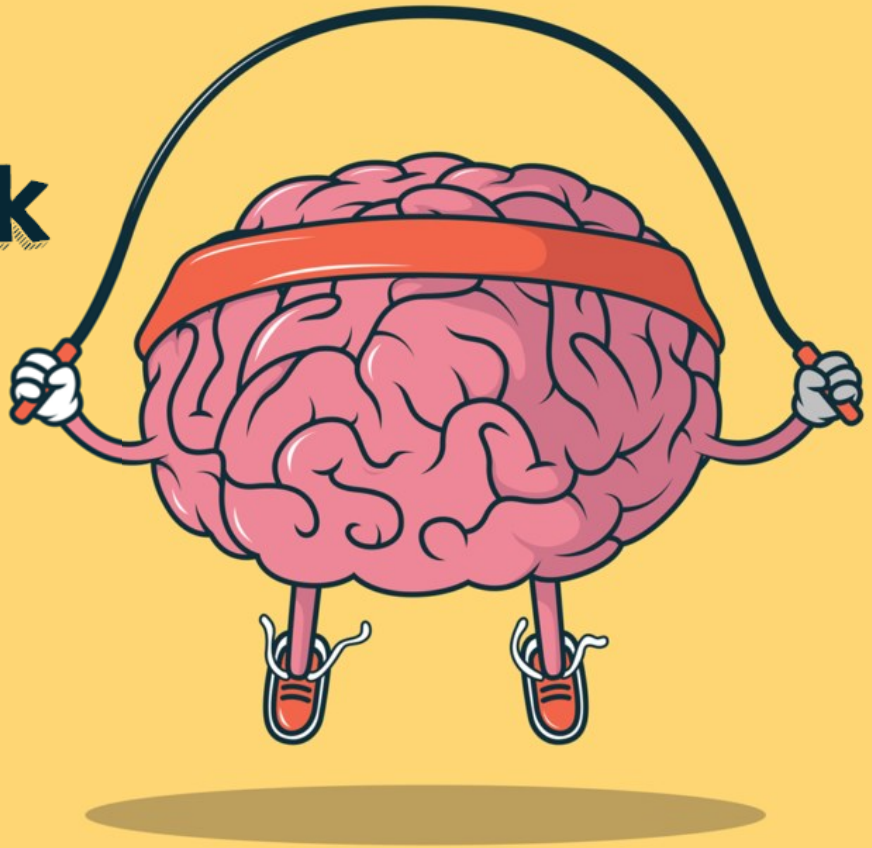

### Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will learn how to use alliteration in their work. The children will wear their green thinking hats to create a piece of writing about zoo animals and will assess the effectiveness of using alliteration. At home, ask your child to identify examples of alliteration in the stories you read together.

### Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will be looking at subtraction and will use the various tools in their 'big thinking toolbox' to support them when solving simple subtraction questions. At home, you can use concrete objects to practise both addition and subtraction questions with your child.

### Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their explorations of Forces and Motion. We will examine friction, exploring what friction is and how it affects us in our everyday lives. They will make a prediction about which material will make the car travel down the ramp the fastest. At home, after reflecting on the results of the experiment at school, why not conduct your own experiment considering what other materials that might cause more or less friction.

### Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will continue learning about Victorian era. The children will look at similarities of food eaten then and now. We will contrast food eaten by the rich and poor. During Victorian times, the food people ate and how they ate it underwent significant changes. At home, you could discuss the emergence of distinct etiquette surrounding dining during Victorian era.
