Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lessons, the children will be exploring the wonderful work of Dr Seuss. The children will look at rhyming words and will use the superpowers of the Creative Camel to create their own nonsense words within their own text. At home, encourage your child to match rhyming words and to highlight rhyming words they hear when reading. In Phonics, the children will look at the 'qu' sound and are encouraged to utilise the activities and online library provided on Reading Eggs and Reading Eggspress.

Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will be learning to use Numicon to represent a number. The children will be adding Numicon to their 'Big Thinking Toolbox' and will be solving simple addition and subtraction problems using this resource. At home, encourage your child to solve simple problems and ask to use their metacognitive skills to plan the task and to choose appropriate strategies to support them.

Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children will learn about magnetism, investigate and learn what Magnetism is. Childen will learn that the pull of a magnet is the magnetic force. Children will be able to explore which materials/objects are magnetic and which are not. Conduct a simple investigation and record results on a tick sheet.

At home, encourage your child to come up with a investigation and record the results on a simple tick sheet.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will understand that a lot of the objects that we use today were invented by the Victorians. We will look at the importance of these inventions. The children will research different Victorian inventions. At home, encourage your child to create a poster explaining key facts about things that were invented during Victorian era and we are still using them now a days.
