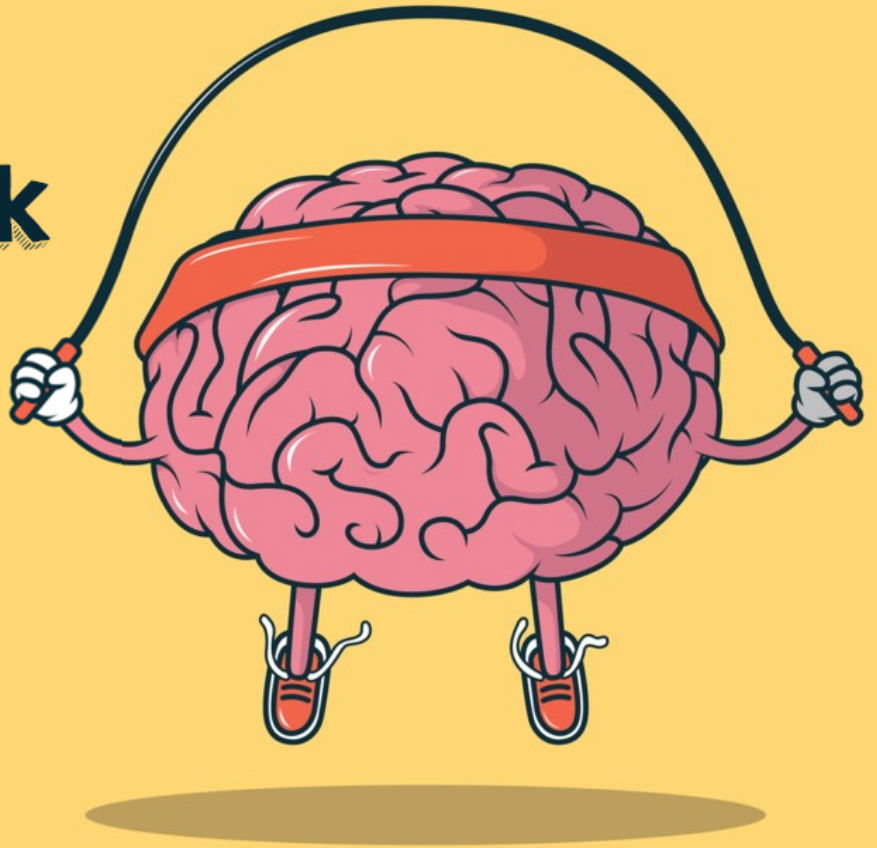

Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will be putting on their green thinking hats and creating an acrostic poem about Winter. The children will be exploring how to create poems that excite the reader and will be working with their friends to evaluate each other's work. At home, encourage your child to create an acrostic poem using the letters of their name.

Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will continue to look at place value and will develop their understanding of partitioning numbers into tens, ones and hundreds. At home, you can continue to utilise Purple Mash to practise partitioning numbers. In Maths Project, the children will learn how to recognise and sort coins. They will be ordering coins from the smallest to highest value and will be challenged to purchase items in their role-play shop. At home, encourage your child to use coins to buy items from the shop.

Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children will look at fossils. The children will understand what fossil fuels are and the impact of burning these. The children will look at identify different types of fossil fuels (oil, coal and gas) and which ones are non-renewable. At home, encourage your child to create a poster with the fossil fuels we use at home.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will look at Victorian literature. The children will understand that Victorian era was a golden age for literature, producing some of the most beloved and enduring works in the English language. The children will also look at many influential authors who explored a wide range of themes, from social justice to mystery and adventure. At home, encourage your child to write a research about one of the authors from this period.
